Greed really isn't all that good in 'Money Monster'

But Clooney and Roberts keep things moving

Bernie Sanders is about to have a new favorite movie. Directed by Jodie Foster, *Money Monster* (★★★ out of four; rated R; in theaters nationwide Friday) is a hostage thriller, a campy satire of the 24/7 media culture and a takedown of Wall Street, though it never fully succeeds on any of those tracks. But those who think the economy is rigged in general, or who are up for George Clooney doing hip-hop moves while wearing a giant dollar-sign necklace, can take stock in finding something to enjoy.

Crank *Mad Money*'s Jim Cramer up to 11 and give him his own dancing girls, and you've got

Clooney's Lee Gates character. He hosts the financial news show *Money Monster*, but the bear market is just a bear for him: A capitals company that Lee advised was a safe bet just lost \$800 million in one day, thanks to a "computer glitch."

The company's CEO (an ultra-smarmy Dominic West) is supposed to come on the show but is MIA. Instead, a young man named Kyle (Jack O'Connell) shows up unannounced on Lee's stage with a gun and a bomb vest to hold the TV personality responsible for the loss of his savings until he can get an answer on what happened.

The drama unfolds mostly in real time, with Lee's producer Patty (Julia Roberts) trying to keep her star calm but also trying to navigate her own investigation into the financial shenanigans that have put her whole crew in harm's way. But in under 100 minutes, an impossible amount

of stuff happens in *Money Monster*, from the police letting a hostage situation spill onto the streets of Manhattan to an impromptu live segment that serves as the movie's endgame.

Foster has crafted a piece that, in places, proves to actually be funnier than might be expected,

and she gets the most out of her fellow A-listers: Roberts is the solid emotional rock of the film, while Clooney's hyper screen pundit has the most complete arc of all the players.

Clooney and O'Connell together offer an unforeseen but welcome buddy-movie spark when

Lee and Kyle find their relationship turned on its head in the movie's second half (which almost makes up for a meandering first part).

Nobody's safe from getting skewered in Jamie Linden, Alan DiFiore and Jim Kouf's screenplay, especially not corporate fat cats, the crowds mindlessly following the live-TV trainwreck and mainstream media on the whole. (In one scene, Patty has the cameraman move so she can get a better shot of Kyle amid the on-air tension.) The inherent anti-greed messaging lacks all subtlety — it might as well have a "Feel the Bern" campaign sticker slapped on the movie's poster. At least with its spiritual cousin *The Big Short*, big bank failings were shown through a more stylized lens.

What *Money Monster* amounts to is a well-meaning indictment of culture, society and the financial sector that could do without an agenda or two.

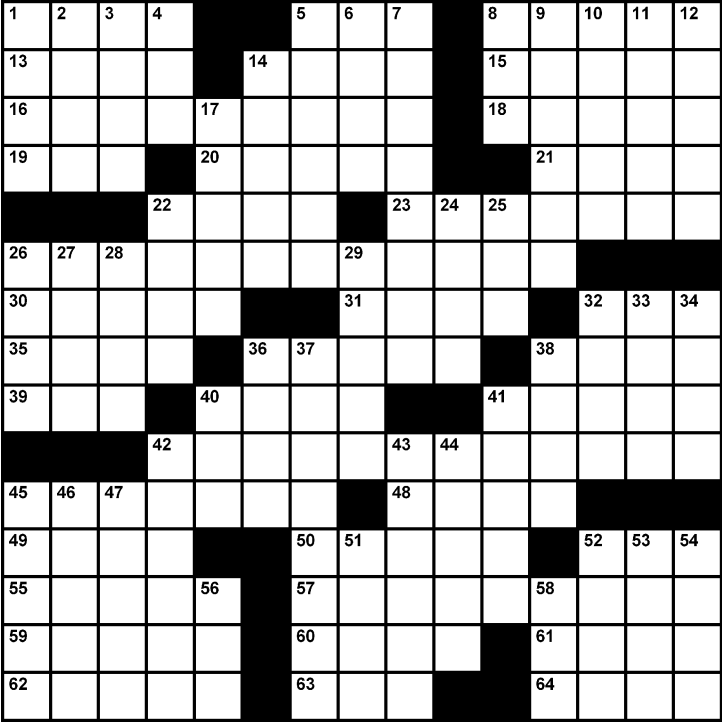

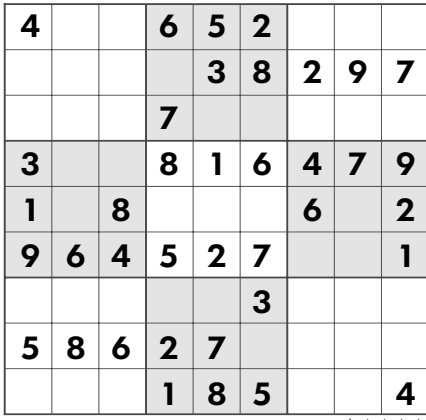

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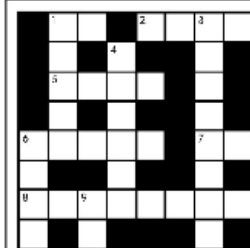

‘Angry Birds’ soars past the superheroes with \$39M

‘Neighbors 2’ knocks at 3 behind ‘Civil War’

Furious fowl ruled the roost at the weekend box office. Moviegoers flocked to see *The Angry Birds Movie*, which took flight with \$39 million and No. 1, according to studio estimates from comScore. The family comedy — an adaptation of the popular app game — scored the third-best animated debut of the year, behind *Zootopia* (\$75.1 million) and *Kung Fu Panda 3* (\$41.3 million). It was enough to knock *Captain America: Civil War* from its perch to No. 2. Budgeted at \$73 million, *Angry Birds* features the voices of Jason Sudeikis, Sean Penn, Maya Rudolph, Danny McBride and Josh

Gad. Despite ruffling a few feathers among critics (reviews were only 42% positive on Rotten Tomatoes), audiences embraced

it slightly more (61% liked it). “It’s a rare bird,” says Paul Derarabedian, senior media analyst for comScore. “The video game as-

pect is drawing that audience that knows the brand, but then there’s the crossover of family audiences who have really been drawn to

PG-rated movies this year.” Dropping to second place in its third week, *Civil War* muscled its way to \$33.1 million, with a total of \$347.4 million stateside and just over \$1 billion worldwide. Opening at No. 3, *Neighbors 2: Sorority Rising* brought down the house with a solid, if not spectacular, \$21.8 million. With just OK reviews (61% positive), the film brought in less than half the business of its predecessor, which premiered with \$49 million in May 2014 on its way to \$150.2 million. Bringing up the rear, Shane Black’s *The Nice Guys* was welcomed with a better-than-expected \$11.3 million in fourth place. Disney’s live-action *The Jungle Book* rounded out the top five with \$11 million in fifth, swinging to a wild \$327.5 million since opening last month. Final figures are expected Monday.

- the inclusion of your property on the appraisal roll
- any exemptions that may apply to you
- the qualification for an agricultural or timber appraisal
- the taxable status of your property
- the local governments which should be taxing your property
- the ownership of the property
- the change of use of land receiving special appraisal
- any action taken by the chief appraiser, appraisal district or appraisal review board (ARB) that applies to and adversely affects you.

Informal Review

Taxpayers may call, e-mail or come by the office and speak with Chief Appraiser Jan Tinsley, or Senior Appraiser Glenda Olivares. We will be glad to answer any questions or concerns you may have.

Review by the ARB

If you cannot resolve your problem informally with the county appraisal district (CAD) staff, you may have your case heard by the ARB.

The ARB is an independent board of citizens that reviews problems with appraisals or other concerns listed above. It has the power to order the CAD to make the necessary changes to solve problems. If you file a written request for an ARB hearing (called a notice of protest) before the deadline, the ARB will set your case for a hearing. You will receive written notice of the time, date and place of the hearing. If necessary, you may request a hearing in the evening or on a Saturday or Sunday. Prior to your hearing, you may ask to review the evidence the CAD plans to introduce at the hearing to establish any matter at issue. The law provides that before a hearing on a protest or immediately after the hearing begins, you or your agent and the CAD shall each provide the other with a copy of any materials - whether in paper or electronic form - intended to be offered or submitted to the ARB at the hearing. (Multiple copies of these materials typically must be brought to the hearing so that each ARB member has a copy of all the materials to review). To the greatest extent practicable, the hearing will be informal. You or a designated agent may appear in person to present evidence or you may send notarized evidence for the ARB to review.

view at your hearing. The CAD representative will present evidence about your case. You may cross-examine the CAD representative. The ARB will make its decision based on the evidence presented. In most cases, the CAD has the burden of establishing the property's value by a preponderance of the evidence presented.

In certain protests, the chief appraiser has the burden of proving the property's value by clear and convincing evidence. You should review ARB hearing procedures to learn more about evidence and related matters. You can get a copy of a protest form from the appraisal district office or from the Comptroller of Public Accounts at comptroller.texas.gov/taxinfo/taxforms/50-132.pdf.

You should not try to contact ARB members outside of the hearing. The law requires ARB members to sign an affidavit saying that they have not talked about your case before the ARB hears it.

Review by the District Court, an Arbitrator or SOAH

After it decides your case, the ARB must send you a copy of its order by certified mail. If you are not satisfied with the decision, you have the right to appeal. If you choose to go to court, you must start the process by filing a petition within 60 days of the date you receive the ARB's order. In certain cases, as an alternative to filing an appeal in district court, you may file, not later than the 45th day after you receive notice of the ARB order, a request for binding arbitration with the county appraisal district. In certain cases, you may appeal to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH). An appeal to SOAH is initiated by, not later than the 30th day after you receive notice of the ARB's order, filing with the chief appraiser of the county appraisal district a notice of appeal. Appeals to district court, binding arbitration, or SOAH all require payment of certain fees or deposits.

Tax Payment

You must pay the amount of taxes due on the portion of the taxable value not in dispute, the amount of taxes due on the property under the order from which the appeal is taken or the amount of taxes due in the previous year.

Deadline for Filing Protests with the ARB*

Usual Deadline

On or before April 30 for residence homesteads and May 31 for all other property (or within 30 days after a notice of appraised value was mailed to you, whichever is later).

Late protests are allowed if you miss the usual deadline for good cause. The ARB decides whether you have good cause.

Late protests are not allowed after the ARB approves the appraisal records for the year.

Special Deadlines

For change of use (the appraisal district informed you that you are losing agricultural appraisal because you changed the use of your land), the deadline is not later than the 30th day after the notice of the determination was delivered to you.

For ARB changes (the ARB has informed you of a change that increases your tax liability and the change did not result from a protest you filed), the deadline is not later than the 30th day after the notice of the change was delivered to you.

Please refer to the date on your Notice of Appraised Value for the protest deadline.

If you believe the appraisal district or ARB should have sent you a notice and did not, you may file a protest until the day before taxes become delinquent (usually Feb. 1) or no later than the 125th day after the date you claim you received a tax bill from one or more of the taxing units that tax your property. The ARB decides whether it will hear your case based on evidence about whether a required notice was mailed to you.

* The deadline is postponed to the next business day if it falls on a weekend or legal, state or national holiday.

NOTICE OF RATE CHANGE REQUEST

Southwestern Electric Power Company (SWEPCO or Company) publishes this notice that on March 16, 2016, it filed its Statement of Intent and Application for Authority to Amend Transmission Cost Recovery Factor (TCRF) with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUCT or Commission) in Docket No. 45691. The filing was made in accordance with the Public Utility Regulatory Act (PURA) § 36.209 and the Tex. Admin. Code (TAC) § 25.239. The TCRF will recover SWEPCO's reasonable and necessary costs for transmission infrastructure improvements as well as changes in wholesale transmission charges under a tariff approved by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) to the extent that the costs or charges have not otherwise been recovered. In this application, SWEPCO seeks to recover its transmission capital investments through December 31, 2015. SWEPCO also seeks to recover through the TCRF approved transmission charges that are not otherwise being recovered through current rates.

This notice is being published in accordance with PURA § 36.103 and 16 TAC § 22.51(a)(1).

STATEMENT OF INTENT TO CHANGE RATES

SWEPCO requests that the Commission approve a TCRF that would result in an increase in SWEPCO's Texas retail revenue requirement of \$4,922,815 per annum above the amount approved in SWEPCO's previous TCRF case (PUCT Docket No. 44496). This amounts to a 1.55 percent increase in SWEPCO's overall annualized current Texas retail revenue requirement. SWEPCO proposes that its requested rate change become effective 35 days after the filing of the Statement of Intent and Application. The proposed effective date is subject to suspension and extension by actions that may be taken by the Commission.

All customers in SWEPCO's Texas retail rate classes will be affected by this change. The impact of the rate change on various customer classes will vary from the overall impact described in this notice.

REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY RATES

SWEPCO requests that the Commission or assigned administrative law judge issue an order establishing SWEPCO's existing TCRF as a temporary rate effective 120 days after the filing of the Statement of Intent and Application subject to refund or surcharge to the extent the TCRF established pursuant to the Statement of Intent and Application differs from the existing TCRF.



Chief Deputy Lain placed Coffee under arrest for cruelty to non-livestock animals and transported him to the Camp County Jail without incident.

Sheriff McCandless placed the bottom half of the carrier, with the puppy still inside, in the back of his patrol vehicle.

"It appeared one of the dog's front legs was broken," Sheriff McCandless said. "I transported the puppy to Pittsburg Veterinary Clinic for medical attention, and it was determined the puppy had a broken leg, a hemorrhages in the left eye and both ear canals, and a concussion as well as symptoms of spinal trauma. Its complete body was bruised from the beating. It underwent

surgery, and a pin was put in the joint of its leg with the hopes of a full recovery."

A seizure warrant was obtained for not only the injured dog, but also the other one.

"Later that day we transported the other puppy to the veterinary clinic to be examined," the sheriff said. "It had worms and a form of mange but was otherwise fine. Both dogs will require several follow-up visits to the veterinarian."

After their ordeal, the puppies found a good home, according to Sheriff McCandless.

"A family agreed to adopt them together since they were litter mates," he said.

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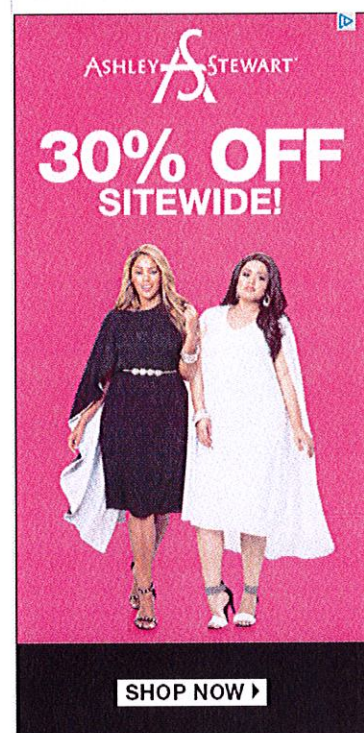
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
