Kesha makes a spontaneous 'Ghost Story' cameo

'Tik Tok' pop star also co-wrote a song for the drama

In *A Ghost Story*, the most unexpected guest at a suburban house party isn't a bedsheet-clad phantom.

Instead, it's Kesha, the glittery pop rebel of *Tik Tok* fame who has been caught up in a legal battle with mega-producer Dr. Luke, whom she has accused of sexual assault. The singer/songwriter makes a blink-and-you'll-miss-it appearance midway through *Ghost Story* (in theaters Friday in New York and Los Angeles, expands to additional cities through July) at a get-together in the former Dallas home of the late C (Casey Affleck) and his partner, M (Rooney Mara).

The heady drama's director, David Lowery, considers himself a Kesha superfan, citing *Die Young, Warrior* and *C'mon* as some of the "most anthemic pieces of pop in the last 20 years."

He hoped to use a Kesha song in a party sequence, but wound up getting her to not only appear in the movie but also co-write a tune that plays in the background.

The cameo was a "crazy coincidence," Lowery says. "(A) friend was at a party that Kesha just happened to be at and was like, 'Hey, I've got some friends in Texas and they want you to be in their movie.' Two days later, she flew to Texas and did it. It was so last-minute and spontaneous that

I was really worried that she'd get there and be disappointed and realize that she had very little to actually do in that scene. ... Thankfully, she did it and had a blast."

In the scene, professional magician Jared Kopf performs tricks for Kesha, who is credited as "Spirit Girl" in the movie.

"All of the dialogue is just him performing and her reacting naturally," Lowery says. "We set up a camera and shot it live, so it's 100% just her. But in part of his routine, he always invokes a spirit. He knew what the movie was about, so he was playing it up and she was responding. It's very on the nose on one level, but also very appropriate on another."

Kesha's song, titled *Last One* and performed by Detroit twinsister duo Stereo Jane, was cowritten with Toby Halbrooks and Andrew Tinker, who wrote music for Lowery's *Pete's Dragon* remake last year.

"They had written a beat with a hook and asked her if she would finish it," Lowery says. "She went and wrote the rest of it, and it was just kind of a dream come true."

The filmmaker hopes to again collaborate with the singer, who has guest-starred on TV shows including *Nashville*, *Jane the Virgin* and *Animals*.

"I'd love to make a movie just starring her. She's a wonderful presence and a wonderful human being," Lowery says. "I know she loves whales and has a giant whale tattoo, and whales are my favorite animal. ... I haven't thought that far ahead, but I could spend 20 minutes just thinking about her personality and her spirit, and a story would emerge."

'Dance Moms' star Abby Lee Miller reports to Calif. prison

Former Dance Moms reality star Abby Lee Miller checked into federal prison Wednesday in Victorville, Calif., about a two-hour drive from Los Angeles.

More than a year after pleading guilty in federal court in Pittsburgh, Miller has reported to the FCI Victorville facility to begin serving her 366-day sentence. In May, she was sentenced for bankruptcy fraud and bringing \$120,000 in of Australian currency into the country without reporting it.

In addition to prison time, a

pay a \$40,000 fine and spend two years on probation after her release.

In the case, prosecutors said Miller was in Chapter 11 bankruptcy when she tried to hide \$775,000 worth of income from her Lifetime network reality show and its spinoffs.

The investigation began when channel-surfing bankruptcy judge saw Miller on TV in December 2012 and figured that she had to be making more than the \$8,899 a month she was claiming.

In prison, "I'll just have me to concentrate on and that's different," she told Entertainment Tonight Saturday. "I've always put everybody else's child first, before

federal judge also ordered her to my own health, before my own outfit, before my own time frame. Everybody else was dressed and out the door and looking perfect and I was running around trying to find a clean towel to take a shower with, so I think this will be a little 'me' time."

Miller announced in March 2016 that she was leaving Dance Moms.

In an Instagram post, she declared that she would no longer participate in the series as she had "ASKED, BEGGED, AND EVEN DEMANDED CREATIVE CREDIT FOR ALL THE IDEAS, AWARD WINNING ROUTINES, THEMES, AND COSTUMING" without success.



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
