In a very busy week for Buckeye track teams, Gilmer competed in all grades from 7th through 12th as Gilmer split their varsity boys team, sending part to the Texas Relays in Austin, and others to the Walter Derrick Relays in Gladewater.

The varsity boys finished 3rd with 115 points behind Kilgore's first with 170 points and Pine Tree's second at 118.5 points.

The Gilmer varsity girls scored no less than three points in each of the 17 categories for a total 208 points ahead of Gladewater's 96 points, Center's 92 points and Spring Hill's 77 points.

The day before the junior varsity boys held their District 16-4A meet. Gilmer's JV finished 4th, behind Kilgore, Chapel Hill, and Pine Three.

On Tuesday, the Bruce Junior High thin clads had their district meet. Both the seventh and eighth grade girls teams won district with 136 for the seventh grade. The eighth grade tied with Kilgore at 147.333 points. The junior high boys finished 3rd in both the seventh and the eighth grades. The seventh grade scored 106 points and the eighth third with 107 points.

On Friday and Saturday, a handful of Buckeyes were in the Texas Relays in Austin. (See separate story).

Alondria Dominiqua took 1st place in three events: 800 M Run (2:31.50), 1600 M Run (5:44.00), and the 3200 M Run (12:49.50.) In each event, she had two other Lady Buckeyes running with her: 2. Laney Medrano and 6. Evelyn Ramirez in the 800 M Run; 4. Adela Pogue and 6. Medrano in the 1600 M Run; and 3. Pogue and 4. Ramirez in the 3200 M Run.

Johnae Newsome won the 300 M Hurdle in 49.26 with Cate Dodd finishing 4th while Gilmer took 2-3-5 in the 100 M Hurdle with Newsome 2nd, Dodd 3rd and Jolie Jones 5th.

The quartet of Taryn Tennison, Tasiya Lewis, Evelyn Applegate and Alondria Nelson were 2nd in the 4X100 M Relay and in the 4X200 M Relay. Applegate joined with Newsome, Kyah Jimmerson, and Adleigh France to win the 4X400 M Relay in 4:09.47.

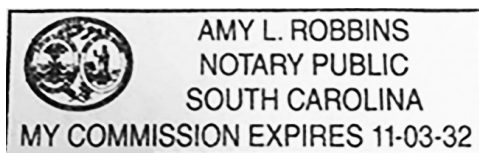

Why Sporting KC has ‘never been in this situation before’ with coaching search

Sporting Kansas City co-principal owner Mike Illig found himself in a strange place Tuesday, explaining the organization’s decision to move on from its manager.

Since 2010, Peter Vermes had held the position of head coach, as well as several others, for KC’s Major League Soccer club. Earlier this week, the team announced that Vermes was out, with longtime assistant Kerry Zavagnin becoming interim boss.

Sporting KC simply didn’t operate like other MLS clubs when it came to coaching stability. More than a third of the league’s 30 coaches are in their first season with their respective teams.

Vermes arrived on Kansas City’s staff in 2006, when the team was known as the Wizards, and the same year that founder Lamar Hunt sold the team to Cerner co-founders Neal Patterson and Cliff Illig.

“We’ve never been in this situation before,” Mike Illig said Tuesday. “Peter is all we’ve ever

known. Here we are, with our first head-coaching change.

“I’m learning through this process. We’ll take our time, get it right. I want to see what’s out there.”

Sporting KC is winless in six MLS games this season, and 13 straight dating to last year. That prompted this week’s change, an ongoing process that will be guided by two search firms and a wide reach.

“We are going to run a global search alongside (Zavagnin), and he’ll be thrown into the mix,” Illig said. “I’ve told him it’s his job to lose.”

But Illig said he’s “been inundated with amazing candidates and agents, so I’m looking forward to running the process.”

Vermes wore several hats for the organization over the years while he was coaching. Now, Sporting KC will redefine the position.

“Peter was a unicorn, in that he literally had his hand in every single aspect of what we call ‘the Sporting player enterprise,’” Illig said. “So, it’s going to take a little while to unravel that. It’s unrealistic to look for someone to do the all-encompassing job.”

Zavagnin and Vermes came to Kansas City together as players in 2000 and were teammates on that season’s MLS Cup championship team. Zavagnin had been part of Sporting’s staff with Vermes since 2009.

His first game running the club solo is Saturday at Children’s Mercy Park against St. Louis.

“He’s carries great respect among the group,” Illig said. “It’s not a rinse-and-repeat with the Peter way. It’s up to him to create his own identity for how he wants the culture of the club and team to exist.”

Illig emphasized in a meeting with the team’s players that the season’s objectives won’t change with a new leader. Sporting KC stands 0-5-1, last in the Western Conference, and owns the worst record in MLS.

At least for now.

“They’re ready for the challenge,” Illig said. “It’s a new season. It begins today.”

since 2019.

Reid said there was a reason Kelce was out there so much.

“We were banged up at the outside (receiver) positions, and that doesn’t help the tight ends’ cause at all,” Reid said. “So I just think the healthier we can be around him, he can still be productive.”

Will there be other changes for Kelce during the 2025 campaign? And perhaps in practice, too?

Reid said it was too early to know, but he’d be open to potentially easing off his veteran a bit.

It wouldn’t be an easy transition. Kelce has historically taken every practice rep, even after the Chiefs have told him that isn’t something he has to do.

That work ethic has constantly drawn praise from teammates and coaches, though, who believe Kelce’s actions help set the standard for the rest of the team.

“We’ll see how it all goes going forward,” Reid said of Kelce’s practice

reps. “Try to play off of what I think he’s got. With all the guys, I do that. So we’ll just see where he’s at.”

Reid said he’s known for a while that Kelce wanted to continue to play this season. He said he could sense that enthusiasm even when the two met for an exit interview just after February’s Super Bowl loss to the Philadelphia Eagles.

“He wants to come back, and he’s training like crazy, too,” Reid said. “So it’s good.”

Someone else pleased that Kelce is making a return? Chiefs owner Clark Hunt.

On Monday, Hunt said that deep down he believed right after the season Kelce would want to keep playing.

“He loves the game. He loves his teammates,” Hunt said. “I know Coach Reid’s excited to have his energy back in the building for at least one more year.”

And perhaps 2025 won’t be it, either. Though few

tight ends are productive into their late-30s, Hunt said he wouldn’t be surprised if Kelce wanted to lengthen his playing career.

“I think it’s true of any long-tenured veteran that you don’t really know when they’ve reached the end,” Hunt said. “He’s not going to tell us which year is going to be his last year. And so I think we have the possibility that he extends his career beyond this.”

This much is certain: Hunt will enjoy seeing Kelce playing alongside quarterback Patrick Mahomes again next season.

“He’s already a Hall of Famer at this point,” Hunt said of Kelce. “He has a special chemistry with Patrick, and I think, like every year, it’s going to be fun to see the two of them work their magic.”

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Missouri Tigers QB hits transfer portal. He was backup for Brady Cook in 2024

Missouri Tigers quarterback Drew Pyne has entered the NCAA transfer portal, according to multiple media reports, including from On3.

Pyne, a graduate student, will head to his fourth school after one year in Columbia.

Pyne joined Mizzou as the backup to longtime Tigers QB Brady Cook and appeared in six games with two starts (due to a Cook injury). Most notably, Pyne led the Tigers in their wild fourth-quarter comeback win over Oklahoma, with Zion Young’s scoop-and-score fumble return with 22 seconds left giving Mizzou the win.

The performance came just one week after Pyne threw three interceptions and posted just 42 passing yards in the Tigers’ 34-0

loss at Alabama.

“I just can’t say how proud I am of Drew Pyne,” head coach Eli Drinkwitz said following the Oklahoma win. “I feel like I’m up here all the time having to defend my quarterback, which is not great. But for all the crap that he’s taken on Twitter and X, and to come out here and ignore the noise ... he goes out there and delivers in the (biggest) moments in the fourth quarter after fans have been booing. He just goes out there and delivers.”

Pyne leaves Columbia with 391 passing yards as a Tiger and three touchdowns.

This spring, Pyne was expected to be part of a three-man competition for the starting job, with Sam Horn’s return from Tommy John surgery and Penn State transfer Beau Pribula’s arrival in Columbia.

The former four-star

recruit from New Canaan, Connecticut, started his career at Notre Dame and earned the starting nod in 2022 after the original starting QB, Tyler Buchner, suffered a regular-season-ending injury in the second game of the season.

Pyne posted an 8-2 record as a starter for the Fighting Irish, but entered the transfer portal at the conclusion of the season and did not participate in Notre Dame’s Gator Bowl win that season.

He transferred to Arizona State for the 2023 season but only appeared in two games before returning to Notre Dame to finish his degree and ultimately transfer to Mizzou for his MBA upon graduation.

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Morikawa senses Tour golfers took pre-LIV life for granted

Collin Morikawa went through most of last season “guessing” whether he could execute any given golf shot and decided the only way forward was to return to the starting line. He’s fairly confident LIV Golf and the PGA Tour could benefit from doing the same.

“It’s really hard to do that, really hard to take two steps back. I don’t think a lot of guys could admit they’ve taken two steps backwards,” Morikawa said at Augusta National Golf Club on Tuesday. “And that’s what I had to do. Start from the very basics of my golf game into college and say, ‘What are the pieces we’re going to, not rebuild, but just fit back together. Piece together and layer one on top of the other.’ The only way to do that is to take two steps back.”

Morikawa, the World No. 4, said he’s excited to share the course with one-time Tour peers and top-ranked players who’ve jumped to LIV Golf for the first time since the Ryder

Cup in Paris, and wondering if his peers took the harmony of professional golf for granted.

“I enjoy it. I think everyone enjoys it. All those guys were amazing to me. They still are. Look, I think the golf world enjoys seeing everyone playing together. I don’t think

anyone would say no to that,” Morikawa said of sharing the Masters’ field with Jon Rahm and others who’ve defected from the traditional circuit.

“It’s amazing how much we take for granted ... in life, I think.”

Asked what he meant by the ending statement,

Morikawa continued: “You look back at whenever LIV started, this whole debacle started, back then when I first turned pro, no one really complained. Right? You just, we enjoyed it. But then this all happened. “You take things for granted -- you get my

point? You look back and you’re like, man, we had it pretty good. Everyone always talks about money. I think the money things needs to get pushed aside. It’s just being golfers, being professional golfers. Playing. These weeks are special now. You don’t take them lightly.”

Morikawa said he welcomes any solution that’s best for the PGA Tour.

“I haven’t sat in those meetings and I know guys have sat countless hours. I thank them for that. That’s up to the whole board and stuff. They’ll figure something out one way or the other,” he said.

After playing 13 holes on the course Tuesday in a practice-round loop, Morikawa said he’s learned in a peek at the course and in five previous starts and three consecutive top-10 finishes in the major that preparation can only carry a player so far.

“We’re always searching for new answers, searching for a new way to hear it,” Morikawa said. “Life moves on. Your body moves on. ... It’s all just kind of feels and guesses. It’s a never-ending search. You are going to continue to do it because you want to get better. What I realized through the process was, I could have all the answers but I’ve got to go play golf. Playing golf is the most important part.”

The results of an MRI performed on Seattle Mariners outfielder Victor Robles revealed a small fracture in his left shoulder, the team announced Tuesday.

While it appears Robles will avoid surgery, the team expects Robles’ fracture to heal in approximately six weeks. At that point, he will need a rehab schedule of an additional six weeks in order to get up to speed.

Robles was placed on

the 10-day injured list Monday, one day after he made a jumping catch of a long ball hit by Patrick Bailey of the San Francisco Giants in the bottom of the ninth that had barely turned foul.

His glove hand still outstretched, Robles’

elbow appeared to make contact with a padded wall and he also got tangled in netting. Robles was carted off the field.

Robles, 27, joined the Mariners after being waived by the Washington Nationals during the 2024 season. Robles was Seattle’s leadoff batter in its

first 10 games of this season, hitting .273 with three doubles, three RBIs, three runs and three stolen bases.

Robles has batted .248 in his 617-game career with Washington (2017-24) and Seattle, recording 35 homers, 185 RBIs, 257 runs and 103 stolen bases.

But the biggest thing is I felt I got ahead for the most part and I stayed ahead. So it kind of puts them on a little bit of a swing mode, I guess.

“I’m going to be in the zone and trust the guys behind me.”

The Twins struggled to catch up to Ragans’ fastball. The pitch registered 24 swings and three whiffs. Ragans paired his changeup, knuckle-curve and slider around the

devastating fastball.

As a result, Ragans worked efficiently. He registered 63 of 96 pitches for strikes and scattered just four hits.

“Cole was unbelievable,” Vinnie Pasquantino echoed. “That’s a really good lineup over there.”

Ragans now has consecutive games with 10 or more strikeouts. In his last 11 innings, Ragans has surrendered two earned runs, nine hits and recorded 21 strikeouts.

“It’s great to see what he’s doing,” Witt said. “Just the work he puts in — everything he does — the preparation is just incredible.”

The Royals have relied on their pitching in recent games. There have been quality starts from Ragans, Michael Lorenzen and

Kris Bubic during KC’s three-game winning streak.

Ragans left with a no decision Tuesday. However, he proved why the Royals invested in him with a new three-year extension this offseason.

And emphasized why he’s an emerging superstar around the league.

“He looked awesome,” Royals manager Matt Quatraro said. “He was commanding everything and had plus-carry on his fastball. A lot of swing and miss. As we know, when you have to get ready for his fastball, his changeup is elite. He threw a lot of good curveballs and sliders as well.”

Ragans is 16-11 with a 2.99 ERA in 47 career starts with the Royals. He has 336 strikeouts in 274 innings pitched.

Auburn fits together transfer-heavy roster

AUBURN, Ala. – Maybe Bruce Pearl had a point.

Ahead of Auburn basketball’s 70-64 victory over 2-seed Michigan State in the Elite Eight, the Tigers coach said his team, the Men’s NCAA Tournament’s top overall seed, was the underdog.

“Most of our guys are guys that were midmajors or junior college or Division II,” Pearl said. “I’m not going to let Michigan State play the underdog card, even though we’re No. 1 seed and they’re No. 2 seed. No, they’re Michigan State. They’re Kansas, they’re Duke, they’re North Carolina. And we’re Auburn. We know our place.”

Auburn was a 5.5-point favorite heading into Sunday’s contest. That prediction proved accurate. But Pearl was right in one sense.

His team, which plays 1-seed Florida in the program’s second Final Four appearance on Saturday (6:09 p.m. EDT, CBS), isn’t littered with blue-chips. The Tigers have a single five-star recruit. Only two members of their roster were top-100 high school prospects.

It’s not like Duke or Houston, which each have at least six former top-100 recruits in their programs. Auburn’s build-out isn’t necessarily intentional, but there’s a method to it.

“We feel like a really good job of doing it with different groups of kids, players,” Auburn associate head coach Steven Pearl told the Montgomery Advertiser. “You’ve got to bring in pieces that fit with what you currently have, and I feel like that gets lost on a lot of staffs.”

A look at how Auburn’s coaching staff built its title-winning roster.

Ja’Heim Hudson (2025)

Recruiting a player like Ja’Heim Hudson isn’t always an easy sell. Auburn’s frontcourt was relatively set ahead of the 2024-25 season. Johni Broome, Dylan Cardwell and Chaney Johnson were returning, but the Tigers still needed a depth piece.

“In that process, you’ve just got to be really upfront and honest with the guys about what they’re walking into,” Steven Pearl said. “And you’ve just got to hope that you’re able to find one that’s not scared of competition, because in today’s day and age, so many people want guarantees. We don’t do that.”

As the season progressed, Hudson came into his role as a reserve. He’s risen to it, especially at crucial junctures where injures sidelined Broome. Steven Pearl pointed to Auburn’s win at Georgia, where Hudson played 18 minutes, scored five points and grabbed three rebounds.

Miles Kelly (2025)

Miles Kelly’s didn’t pass the eye test. At Georgia Tech last season, he had a 98 offensive rating, shot 32% from distance and 42% on two-point attempts. He also had a higher turnover rate than assist rate.

“What you have to do is you have to

go watch the film,” Steven Pearl said. “And when you watch the film, you could see how good he was.”

Kelly was also playing the star on a team that finished four games below .500. At that point, an assessment gets made: What would it look like if he was on a team with better players? What if he was asked to do less?

At Auburn, Kelly’s offensive rating is up 20 points. His 3-point percentage has jumped six points, and his two-point percentage five.

“We knew that surrounding him with better players, one, it would take a lot of the burden off of him offensively, to where he could concentrate on taking good shots instead of tough shots,” Steven Pearl said. “That would also allow him to play better defense, because he wasn’t having to save so much energy for the offense since they relied on him so much.”

Chad Baker-Mazara (2024)

Connections matter in recruiting, especially in the transfer portal.

That was the case when Chad Baker-Mazara came out of Northwest Florida State. He had connections to Auburn assistant Ira Bowman. Then a call to an assistant at San Diego State, where Baker-Mazara had played, gave Steven Pearl the rundown.

“He said, ‘You are absolutely going to love Chad. He is a bucket-getter. He is an unbelievable basketball player. But he is also capable of doing some things that will just make you pull your hair out.’ So, he wasn’t wrong,” Steven Pearl recalled. “Chad is all those things.”

The latter wasn’t a red flag. Players like Baker-Mazara aren’t a bet on which Auburn’s staff is scared to take.

“We feel like we do a really good job with people like Chad Bakers and KD Johnsons,” Steven Pearl said. “Those high-risk, high-reward players. ... It’s obviously paid off a lot more than it’s hurt us.”

Chaney Johnson (2024)

An area where Auburn’s staff shines

is the recruitment of players it has faced. Think KD Johnson or Johni Broome. Chaney Johnson is another example.

“Part of our job is, if you’re playing against somebody that plays well against you, you kind of keep an eye on them the rest of the year just to see what they do, and no exception to Chaney,” Steven Pearl said.

Chaney Johnson had 14 points and five rebounds for Division II Alabama-Huntsville against Auburn during an exhibition game in November 2022. When he entered the portal, Auburn knew he was someone who could contribute.

Like Hudson, he wasn’t promised anything. He was joining a frontcourt that included Broome, Cardwell and Jaylin Williams.

“Wasn’t scared,” Steven Pearl said. “Came in and wanted to compete and get better and show that he could play at the highest level. He’s done that. He’s come in and been one of the most valuable bench pieces in all of college basketball.”

Denver Jones (2024)

There was little connection between Denver Jones and Auburn when he left FIU for the transfer portal. And his commitment to the Tigers saw factors culminate on both sides.

Like Kelly, Jones was a high-scoring guard on an underachieving team. He was overused. He was also from Alabama, which Steven Pearl said tends to give the Tigers a recruiting advantage.

One of the last pieces in it all came back to connections. FAU’s coaching staff, then led by Michigan coach Dusty May, was quite high on Jones when Steven Pearl called.

“I trust those guys, because that’s one of the best staffs in the country,” Steven Pearl said. “You will respect certain opinions more than others, and that was an opinion that I needed to hear from before I could sign off on it and really push it further down the road.”

Johni Broome (2023)

Steven Pearl was attending a coaches consortium at the 2022 Final Four when Walker Kessler called to let his coach know he was entering the NBA draft.

“Johni Broome ends up in the portal, like, five minutes later,” Steven Pearl said.

It was enough for Steven Pearl to immediately walk out of the room and call Broome and his father, John Broome Sr. Earlier that season, the forward posted 12 points and eight rebounds against Auburn.

“I was like, ‘Hey, listen, Walker Kessler’s leaving,’” Steven Pearl said. “‘You know, National Defense Player of the Year, third-team All-American, first-team All-SEC. We need the best big in the portal. You’re that guy for us.’”

Auburn had watched more than Johni Broome’s game against it to know that. He was a different caliber on the offensive end, and the staff was adamant about not only what Broome could give them, but how they could grow his game.

The tipping point in it all, at least to Steven Pearl, was the relationship he and Bruce Pearl built. That became vital when the program believed Broome would end up a Florida Gator.

“But we ended up flying up to Morehead, Kentucky, a couple days before he (Broome) decided to commit to us,” Steven Pearl said.

Bruce and Steven Pearl spent that morning working with Broome. They went to Cracker Barrel, again going over their pitch. But they left without a commitment from Broome. The head coach was discouraged, Steven Pearl said. But his son insisted otherwise.

“I was like, ‘No, just hang in there. I think he knows what he wants to do,’” Steven Pearl said. “‘He just didn’t want to give you the answer right then and there. I think he needs to talk to his dad and his mom and his family.’”

A couple of days later, the coaches were at a wedding in Atlanta. Broome called, and he had good news: He’d be coming to Auburn.

“I think the details that we gave them, the commitment that we showed them throughout the process and the vision that we showed them,” Steven Pearl said, “just our need for somebody at his position, I think, at the end of the day, is what really tipped it over the edge.”

Coach cites hard work, maturity behind Gators’ run

GAINESVILLE, Fla. – The Florida men’s basketball team will embark on its sixth Final Four trip in school history, and first since 2014, when the Gators leave for San Antonio on Wednesday to prepare for their showdown Saturday against Auburn in the Alamodome (6:09 p.m. EDT, CBS).

Florida coach Todd Golden has led the program on an upward trajectory,

going from 16 wins in his first season to 24 wins in his second season to 34 wins and counting in Year 3.

“We’re not doing anything unique,” Golden said. “We’re not doing anything magical. We’re just working really hard and trying to make sure we have the right people in our program to do that.”

“But I think we’re seeing the benefits of a lot of the hard work we did in years one or two this year, seeing our younger guys mature, seeing our staff really come together being on a same page and

have a great understanding of how each other works.”

On Florida basketball’s ability to close out games

UF rallied from a six-point deficit in the second half to beat UConn in the Round of 32 and came back from down 10 points in the second half in the Elite Eight to take down Texas Tech.

Golden attributed it to UF’s maturity, with three senior starters in the back-

court: All-American senior point guard Walter Clayton Jr., grad transfer guard Alijah Martin and senior guard Will Richard, a three-year starter.

“Instead of letting our emotions get the best of us or pointing fingers, we did a good job staying the course,” Golden said. “Obviously, our guys did a good job understanding now or never (over the) last five minutes and made every big play down the stretch. But, again, the consistency, the maturity and their belief in each other is a big part of that.”

Don't sleep on Rahm at Masters

AUGUSTA, Ga. – Don't sleep on Jon Rahm this week at the 89th Masters.

Since taking a boatload of money to go to LIV, the 2023 Masters champion has become golf's forgotten man. The former world No. 1 in the Official World Golf Ranking has been playing in obscurity, racking up top-10 finishes but his major record was spotty last season – T-45 at the Masters, missed cut at the PGA Championship, a withdrawal at the U.S. Open due to injury and a back-door top-10 at the British Open.

LIV events don't earn world ranking points, which makes it harder to judge where he stands in the game. But when the Spaniard, who turned 30 in November, shifts into Rambo mode, he might be the best player in the world. Here are five reasons he could pick up his second Green Jacket and third major overall.

'Unfairly judged'

When asked where he would rank himself, Rahm wondered whether he was still in the top 100.

"A couple weeks to go, and I'll be gone," said Rahm, who entered the week at No. 80. "I mean, I'm not going to say exactly a number, but I would still undoubtedly consider myself a top-10 player in the world."

He added: "But I think last year the state of my game was being unfairly judged based on how I played here and at the PGA compared to how I really

played throughout the whole year. It's hard to tell nowadays."

Data Golf, which is a better judge these days of where Rahm ranks, has him ranked No. 4. He ain't No. 80, that's for sure!

Knost: 'As good as ever'

CBS's Colt Knost has a better idea than most of Rahm's form. He said he played with Rahm recently and his game looks as good as ever. "It wouldn't surprise me at all if he was wearing a Green Jacket again on Sunday," Knost said.

Game trending

In the second half of last season, Rahm finished runner-up in the Spanish Open, T-5 in the Olympics in Paris and T-7 in both the British Open at Royal Troon and a DP World Tour event in St. Andrews. How is Rahm feeling about his early-season form on LIV?

"Feeling good, feeling very good," he said. "Playing at Doral last week was extremely challenging. It was definitely one of the hardest setups I've played. And besides one bad score on 17 on Sunday, which was actually one of the better swings of the week that led to a very bad

number, I feel really good. I feel like I played better than obviously the score reflects, but at the end of the day, it's golf. Feeling really, really good about this year in general."

Finding balance

Rahm, 30, is now a parent of three, adjusting to the work-life balance struggles of parents everywhere. The Spaniard said he feels more at ease coming into the week than a year ago, when he was the defending champion and his move to LIV remained fresh on everyone's mind. Rahm had recorded five top-10s, including his win at Augusta, before his T-45 last year. This is a course that has always fit his eye.

Feeling superstitious?

Rahm is making his ninth start at the Masters and his preparation does match up in at least one way to 2023. Could it mean that Scottie Scheffler is draping a jacket back on Rahm again?

"Out of those nine, seven I came early to practice, this being the second time that I haven't come early, and the other time was '23, where I ended up winning," Rahm said. "I feel like this year with the third child and other things in the schedule for the year, I didn't have the time to come, at least when the weather was good enough."

Asked if it was a superstitious thing, he said, "No, God no. It just worked out that way. No, if I win this year, then I definitely won't come again early."

DeChambeau hoping experience pays off

AUGUSTA, Ga. – Bryson DeChambeau isn't afraid to admit it. From a very young age, he has dreamed of what it would be like to win a Green Jacket, to be admitted into the Champions Dinner and change shoes in the second-floor locker room reserved for champions.

"Everyone dreams of that opportunity," he said. "I don't think there's a player out here that doesn't think about that."

DeChambeau, 31, is a two-time U.S. Open champion but has yet to harness his power into success at Augusta National. Golf Channel's Brandel Chamblee was blunt in stating his case that despite DeChambeau's opening-round 65 to lead the Masters last year and eventual career-best T-6 finish, he's not convinced that the LIV star and popular YouTube golfer has turned a corner at Augusta National.

"I still don't think the course is a great fit for him," he said. "If you go back 25 years, the winners, there's 1,800 holes they would have played en route to winning the Masters. Collectively, they've made six double bogeys in 1,800 holes. That's .003 percent of the time they've made mistakes. He makes almost two and a half on average every time he plays the Masters. ... There are some places there you just can't miss it big."

Chamblee went on to point out DeChambeau's in-to-out move isn't suited for the hanging lies that are prevalent at Augusta and expressed concern about his scrambling stats on LIV this season.

"He's capable of playing some great

golf there under the right conditions, but generally speaking, no, he's too linear, and that golf course is too abstract," Chamblee said.

DeChambeau has shifted away from his cocky stance that Augusta is a par 67 for him, and when asked to name the toughest hole, he said, "All of them."

In explaining his lackluster record since finishing low amateur in 2016, DeChambeau said, "I haven't learned enough, obviously. I can tell you that it's definitely grown over the course of time. Each year I learn a little bit more about winds and how it affects the golf ball on a certain hole or a certain slope around a pin location, just little things that continue to improve my knowledge around the golf course."

He also didn't have a good enough understanding of how to deal with nerves earlier in his career.

"That was something that I still work on today," he said. "Even last week, I felt nerves last week and going into Sunday, and learning how to control that better and better each time."

DeChambeau's brute strength can be a tremendous asset at Augusta. ESPN analyst Curtis Strange is more bullish on DeChambeau's chances, noting if he has a good driving week, look out.

"It's hard to beat somebody that hits it that far," Strange said. "We always talk about Augusta being a second-shot golf course. Well, what makes it a second-shot golf course easier? It's driving it long and straight."

LIV Doral produces its best ratings yet crushed by PGA

LIV Golf CEO Scott O'Neil said he had no problem being judged off the ratings from last weekend's event at Trump National Doral.

They are in, and it's not encouraging for LIV and O'Neil.

The PGA Tour, in one of its lowest-profile events of the year, crushed LIV, drawing nearly four times the viewers Sunday, according to Josh Carpenter of Sports Business Journal.

The Valero Open in San Antonio, which lacked several stars and was won by Brian Harman, drew 1.746 million viewers for its final round on NBC.

LIV, playing its first U.S.-based event after four international starts in 2025, drew 484,000 during the final round of the tournament won by Marc Leishman.

The Valero ratings were down 20%

from the 2.179 million who watched Akshay Bhatia win last year.

LIV was looking to at least be competitive with the PGA Tour to attempt to regain some of its leverage as the two tours continue to talk about a merger.

The silver lining for LIV, after events in Saudi Arabia, Australia, Hong Kong and Singapore that produced astonishingly low ratings, the number was the Saudi-backed league's best ever, topping 432,000 for the 2024 opener.

LIV's ratings even fell short of TGL's average for its first season in 2025. The indoor, tech-infused golf league created by Tiger Woods and Rory McIlroy averaged 500,000 viewers; 650,000 for the 10 prime-time matches on ESPN (nine were carried by ESPN2).

LIV's Friday number of 369,000 on Fox outdrew the PGA Tour's 318,000 on Golf Channel. But the PGA Tour crushed LIV on Saturday with 1.583 million on NBC compared with 318,000 tuning in to LIV on Fox.

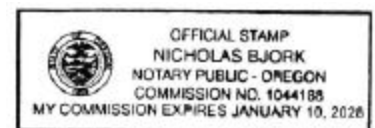
