

After 29 years, this Kansas City dive bar is forced to close: 'They want me out'

BY DAVID HUDNALL

The drinks and conversation were still flowing. But on Sunday night, Gilhouly's was slowly slipping away.

The Volker bar's pool table and jukebox were already gone, retrieved earlier in the day by the vending company. Soon, the tables and chairs would need to be loaded into the U-Haul owner Joe Simone had parked outside on Bell Street. Last call, whenever it came, would be the last last call: Gilhouly's was closing for good.

good.
"They want me out at midnight," Simone said from behind the bar. "I tried to meet with them to talk things over. And if they didn't like what I had to say, then, sure, tell me to go jump in the river. But I guess they weren't interested."

interested."
Simone was referring to the Jang family, which owns all the real estate on the south side of the block on 39th Street between Bell and Genesee streets. That includes 1721 W.
39th St. home to Gil. 39th St., home to Gil-houly's since 1995, when brothers Kenny and Den-nis Daub bought a corner bar called Huck Finn's bar called Huck Finn's and renamed it after a character in the John Ford film "Donovan's Reef" (though the character is spelled "Gilhooley" in the film).

But for much of its life, Gilhouly's has been an Irish bar owned by Italians. Simone bought the bar eight years ago from his brother-in-law, C.J. Mandacina, inheriting the

lease.
Jennifer Jang was Simone's primary contact
on the property. But she
died in 2022, and other
members of her family
took over the real estate
holdings.
"Jennifer was an active
landlord," Simone said.
"If you had an issue —
water, A/C — she'd come
by. These new guys, I've
never even seen them.
And then a few months
ago they gave me a 'We're
not going to renew your
lease' notice."

be reached Monday for comment. Through Block Real Estate, the property's management company, Simone said he tried to broker some kind of al-ternative deal. He was willing to take on a new partner at the bar, or sell it to a new owner. No

"Then I got a message from Block at 4:30 p.m. (Saturday) where they're trying to tell me I owed trying to tell me I owed two months' rent but they'd be willing to accept the bar's furnishings as payment," Simone said, adding that he didn't owe any back rent. He knocked on the wood of the bar. "Simone said." I resurfaced it when I bought this place. I'll take it out with hammers and nails if I have to." Simone said a Block agent told him a few months ago that the Jangs

had a new potential tenant interested in opening
a bar in the space and
were not interested in
purchasing Simone's liquor license, Gilbouly's
has a tavern license,
which are rare and valuable in Kansas City because they do not require
the operators to serve
food. The city rarely issues them.
"A new owner would
have to put in ADA (compliant) bathrooms — we
were grandfathered in, so
we didn't have to change
them — and a kitchen,
and this is only an I,100square-foot space," Simone said, "I don't think
they understand that."

Block Real Estate did not respond to a request for comment. Simone said he's been looking into opening something in the Cross-roads or the Garment District but isn't sure what his next tens will be his next steps will be. "I like this neighbor

"I like this neighbor-hood better when it's full of small places, like (now-closed) Bob Wasabi and D.B. Cooper's," he said. "Things are getting pretty commercialized here lately, and it's taking away the neighborhood feel. Or, that's what I think. I don't know. I

think. I don't know. I guess it's up to the customers to decide."

A bartender called across the bar.
"Hey, Joe," she said, "when are we closing tonight?"
"I don't know," Simone said. "I guess we close once we have this place cleaned out."

Shortstop Bobby Witt Jr. played in his 400th career game Sunday as the Royals thumped the Rockies 10-1 in Denver.

"Thinking back on it now, probably one of the bigger regrets is not maybe seeing if he could have been the lightning rod offensively that he's been for the Royals this year. "But I fell like there was a lot of veterans on that Team USA roster and then eventually in 2026, it'll probably be Bobby Witt and Gunnar Henderson's team and kind of build around that." 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

mond Green were a treat, providing en-tertainment, drama and a dynasty that changed the way basketball is played and viewed.

Those days are over. And perhaps they were unofficially over a year ago when the Warriors lost in the Western Conference semificials. Conference semifinals.

Conference semifinals.

The triumvirate that spearheaded four NBA titles in eight seasons, including three in four seasons, has splintered with Thompson agreeing to a deal with the Dallas Mavericks on July 1.

In Thompson's last game with the Warriors, he had zero points on 0-for-10 shooting from the field and 0-for-6 on 3s. The end had arrived for both sides.

This move is very much about the
Mavericks trying to improve their roster
after losing to the Boston Celtics 4-1 in

cult for a star to remain with the same team for his entire career. Teams and players move on.

Maybe Curry finishes his career with Golden State. But no one will be surprised if he doesn't. The Warriors need to figure out their future. They didn't make the playoffs in 2023-24, and they are not among the top teams headed into 2024-25.

Thompson and Curry were major players in the Great 3-point Revolution. Each player shooting upward of 10 3s per game was normal, and the Warriors crushed teams with their ability to

crushed teams with their ability to spread the floor, tax the defense and make 3s. When they were on, there were no defensive answers.

Thompson is No. 6 on the all-time 3-pointers made list and will pass Reggie Miller for fifth in 2024-25. No teammates shot the ball like Curry, No. 1 all-time in 3s made, and Thompson. The Warrior's fiftees at times was imposel; time in 3s made, and Thompson. The Warriors' offense at times was impossible to defend as Golden State won championships in 2015, 2017, 2018 and 2022. That last title was a send-off. The West was getting deeper, the Warriors older and nothing lasts forever.

He's not the All-Disches of All-Deiense Klay Thompson – or even an All-Star – but alongside Kyrie Irving and Luka Doncic, he helps the Mavs.

Enough to get back to the Finals? That's difficult. The 2018 and 2019 Warriors are the last team to appear in consecutive Finals, and the West is stacked with available to me. with quality teams.

The 2024 WNBA draft class came into the league making history, draw-ing a record 2.45 million viewers to the draft in April, and the rookies haven't stopped rewriting the history books as the halfway point of the regular season approaches.

the first overall pick, became the first rookie in league history to record a triple-double over the weekend. And the pie-double over the Weekend. And the Chicago Sky's Angel Reese, the No. 7 overall pick, set a record for consecu-tive double-doubles. Clark and Reese were named to the 2024 All-Star team, earning their first selection in their first

year in the league. Clark and Reese top the latest USA TODAY Sports' WNBA rookie power rankings (records and statistics going into Wednesday):

1. Caitlin Clark, Indiana Fever

Reese has recorded a double-double in 14 of her first 20 games and leads the league in offensive rebounds (97) and total rebounds (237).

"I just go out there and do my job. My job is to rebound, so I'm going to go out there and do my job and rebound. I thou there and only job and recount... I know that's what my teammates need me to do, and I've committed to that," Reese said after dropping a career-high 27 points in the Sky's 88-84 win over the Storm on July 5.
