Kansas basketball camp scrimmage shortened after an injury

Kansas freshmen Flory Bidunga and Rakease Passmore certainly looked ready for the leap to major college basketball, combining for 24 points in the Blue Team's 46-38 victory over the Red Squad in an injury-shortened intrasquad scrimmage contested in front of Bill Self's campers on Tuesday at Horejsi Center, adjacent to Allen Fieldhouse.

The scrimmage originally was slated to end once one of the teams scored 60 points. However the action was halted early when sophomore guard Elmarko Jackson slipped on a drive to the hoop and suffered some sort of leg injury.

Self, KU's 22nd-year head coach, told the campers, "Elmarko's going to be fine," noting to the campers KU's medical staff immobilized the leg as a precautionary measure. Jackson walked off the court with trainers at his side.

Bidunga, a 6-foot-9 center out of Kokomo (Indiana) High School, scored the first two points of the scrimmage, followed by a slam dunk off a pass from sophomore guard Jamari McDowell. Bidunga also blocked a Dajuan Harris layup try and finished with eight points for the winning Blue Team.

Passmore, a 6-5 guard out of Combine Academy in Lincolnton, North Carolina, knocked down four 3s and scored 16 points, also for the Blue squad.

"I really like his aggressiveness, obviously his athleticism (Bidunga) is fun to guard. He is a very talented guy," said KU senior forward Hunter Dickinson, who had 10 points for the Red Team. "He'll be my teammate for the next year. Hopefully we'll have a relationship where I can mentor him and show him as much as I can. Hopefully I can do (for Bidunga) what guys did for me."

"It's a tough setback but one we'll address head on. We'll figure out a way to get him better through the process. He will figure a way to get better through the process. But he will be limited from basketball opportunities for quite some time." Self said Jackson, a 6-foot-3 native of Marlton, New Jersey, "planted and his knee gave away" on a play in which he was driving with the basketball and went down underneath the goal.

"Elmarko will be able to assume noncontact basketball in the next several months, but the full rehab process will take approximately 12 months," Self said.

In an official news release about Jackson's injury, Self noted: "We are all crushed by this... He will return as good as ever."

Self told The Star Jack-

was good to see him being able to walk it off on his own. We've got a really good training staff that'll get him back as soon as he can."

FORMER JAYHAWKS ATTEND CAMP SCRIMMAGE

Former KU guards Christian Braun (of the NBA's Denver Nuggets) and Tyon Grant-Foster attended the scrimmage and watched from the stands.

Grant-Foster, who averaged 20.1 points and 6.1 rebounds per game last season at Grand Canyon, recently removed his name from the 2024 NBA Draft pool of players. He revealed on social media Tuesday he'd return to GCU for another season.

K-State nears full roster by landing Kentucky transfer

Jerome Tang has made a big addition to the Kansas State basketball roster.

In more ways than one, Ugona Onyenso, a 7-foot forward who spent the past two seasons playing for Kentucky, announced his intentions to transfer to K-State on Tuesday while he was on a recruiting visit to Manhattan.

That is big news for the Wildcats for two reasons. First, he becomes the 12th scholarship player that has committed to play for K-State next season. Tang will have a complete ro-

playing in 24 games last season. But he did make 14 starts for the Wildcats and he was once a highly touted high school recruit. Perhaps a change of scenery will help him reach his full potential as he plays his final two years of college basketball.

The NBA Draft was an option for Onyenso, but he decided to return to college after testing the professional waters last month.

K-State will have a tall frontcourt next season. The Wildcats have also landed Arkansas transfer Baye Fall, who checks in at 6-foot-11.

It has been a busy off-season for Tang and the Wildcats. They lost 10 scholarship players from last year's squad, leaving them with only David N'Guessan, Macaleab Rich and Taj Manning as returning players. Tang has since added seven incoming transfers. They are: Villanova guard Brendan Hausen, Michigan guard Dug McDaniell, Illinois-Chicago guard CJ Jones, Cal-State Fullerton guard Max Jones, Ikegwurika, Samford forward Achor Achor, Fall and now Onyenso.

College basketball expert Evan Miya ranks K-State's incoming transfer class among the top 25 in the nation.

They will complement K-State's high lone incoming high school recruit David Castillo.

Missouri Tigers land two more 2025 football commitments

Eli Drinkwitz has had a busy week of recruiting, and it's only Tuesday.

But the buzziness has certainly paid off for Drinkwitz's squad with two prospects committing to Mizzou in as many days.

The latest commitment, three-star safety Dillon Williams out of Demopolis, Alabama, announced his decision to head to Columbia in a social media video on Tuesday. Williams chose Mizzou over several other SEC and Power Five offers, including from Kentucky, Mississippi State and Ole Miss. He also had an offer from Cincinnati.

A 6-foot-2, 180-pound safety, Williams is the ninth commit for Mizzou's 2025 class. He is ranked No. 63 at his position according to 247Sports.

Williams' commitment comes just one day after Mizzou landed four-star offensive line prospect Henry Fenuku out of North Crowley HS in Fort

Worth, Texas. Fenuku, a 6-foot-4 and 295-pound offensive lineman, received 29 offers after just three years playing football. He is the No. 21-ranked interior offensive line prospect per 247Sports. On3's "Industry Composite" ranking lists him as a four-star prospect.

Originally from Ghana, Fenuku grew up playing soccer before making the move to football. His reported offer list includes names of several prominent Power Five schools, including Florida State and Ohio State, along with several SEC schools in Georgia, LSU, Tennessee and Texas A&M.

Williams and Fenuku now join a 2025 class ranked 19th in the nation and 10th in the SEC, according to On3. The class of nine recruits is headlined by On3 five-star quarterback Matt Zollers, with four four-stars and four three-stars in the mix.

Kansas State Wildcats add talented wide receiver to 2025 football recruiting class

When it comes to recruiting, things are starting to heat up for the Kansas State football team.

Adonis Moise, a 6-foot and 185-pound wide receiver from IMG Academy in Florida, committed to play for the Wildcats on Tuesday. He chose K-State while also holding scholarship offers from Kansas, UCF, Indiana, West Virginia, Vanderbilt and others.

With him on board, K-State has five high school prospects lined up for its 2025 recruiting class. K-State has also landed a string of future players over the past few days.

Over the weekend, the Wildcats landed Tennessee-Chattanooga transfer Colin Truett to its offensive line. Derby defensive back Martel Jackson also chose K-State after he received a scholarship offer from head coach Chris Klieman earlier this month.

Add Moise to the mix and K-State will head into the summer with plenty of recruiting momentum.

It didn't take the Wildcats long to sell themselves to Moise. The talented wide out made a recruiting visit to Manhattan over the weekend and then he pledged his services to K-State less than 48 hours later.

Moise should have a high ceiling as a college football player. Most recruiting services have listed as a three-star recruit, but ESPN sees more potential in him and lists him as a four-star prospect. Overall, ESPN

projects Moise as the 47th best receiver in his recruiting class.

The 2025 recruiting class should continue to grow in the coming weeks. For now, though, Moise joins a group that also includes St. Louis quarterback Dillon Duff, Coppell (Texas) linebacker Weston Polk, Jefferson City offensive lineman Will Kemma and Jackson.

"OTAs, I felt, went real good for me," Moore said. "I feel like I'm getting back into the swing of things with my knee. I'm strong. I'm ready to attack (training) camp with a full head of steam."

Moore said he aims for a more significant role this upcoming season. He began to lose some playing time late last year — a stretch that coincided with Rice emerging as the Chiefs' No. 1 receiver option.

"I need progression," Moore said of this coming season. "Whatever I did last year, the year before, I need better than that. So just be the best player I can be."

Moore, 23, had similar offensive stats during his rookie season. That year, he had 22 catches for 250 yards before picking up his first receiving touchdown in the Chiefs' Super Bowl LVII victory over the Philadelphia Eagles.

has familiarity. He's entering his third year in the Chiefs' system, and when asked about the playbook, the receiver said he has that part down now.

"So going into Year 3, I feel as comfortable as I've been in the offense," Moore said. "And it's definitely a huge plus when I can just go out there and play free."

To ready for next month's training camp, Moore said he planned to continue running over the next few weeks to keep himself in shape. That would include some future workouts in the Florida heat and humidity.

"For some reason, I feel like St. Joe's the hottest place on Earth when we're out there," Moore said with a grin, referencing the Chiefs' training camp location in Missouri. "But that's how I prepare."

Who will follow Biles to Paris for USA?

FORT WORTH, Texas — Simone Biles is a gimme for the Paris Olympics. Because, duh. Did you watch her at the U.S. Championships? Or any other competition since she returned last year?

The question is who joins the four-time gold medalist on the squad for Paris. And that answer is now both clearer in some ways and murkier in others than it was a few days ago.

Suni Lee and Skye Blakely improved their prospects with their performances at nationals last weekend. But now there are concerns about the health of Shilese Jones, who was considered almost as much of a lock as Biles until she withdrew from nationals to protect her injured shoulder.

"There's been a little bit of progress," Jones told NBC on Sunday night. "I woke up and I was like, 'It's feeling a little bit better than this whole week.' It's been a little bit stiff, but some progression today."

The Olympic trials for gymnastics are June 27-30, so it's not time to panic just yet. In the meantime, here's a look at the contenders:

Stock rising

Suni Lee: Lee competed the all-around for the first time since last spring, when a kidney ailment forced her to cut her final season at Auburn short.

If not for a fluke error on vault on the second night — she stubbed her toe on the runway and had to cut her Yurchenko

double to a 1½ — Lee would have finished third.

Lee was fabulous on balance beam, with her 14.9 on Sunday the highest score on the event of the entire meet. She missed being third on uneven bars by a mere 0.050 points despite her routine not having its full difficulty.

"Beam and bars are the one thing I need to — not prove myself on, but that's where I'm going to be the most useful to the team. So I'm glad I could (do) both those (well)," Lee said. "I just have to go back into the gym and work on my consistency, get my bar routine with full difficulty and keep staying consistent on beam."

Skye Blakely: She put together two solid and consistent nights that included the first 15 of her career, for her upgraded Cheng vault.

She was second to Biles in the all-around both nights, and she was top three on vault, bars and beam.

Though she was a member of the last two world championship teams, Blakely played a supporting role. Her performance at nationals showed her — and she hopes the selection committee — that she's ready to be a main contributor in Paris.

"Coming off this meet, I know what I'm capable of now, so that will put even more confidence in myself," she said. "I

see myself in training, so I know what I can do. But to be able to finally put it out there on the floor and show everybody and myself, it really means a lot to me."

Jordan Chiles: The Tokyo Olympian is making steady improvement, but it was her silver medal on uneven bars that really stood out.

Remember that the format for team finals is three gymnasts on each event and all three scores count, and Chiles would give the U.S. women insurance on bars and vault.

Hezly Rivera: The U.S. junior champion last year made quite an impression in her first nationals as a senior, finishing fourth on balance beam and fifth on uneven bars.

Work in Progress

Jade Carey: She has the big vaults, but she needs to score better on floor exercise, where she's the reigning Olympic champion.

That's not a complete surprise, given the quick turnaround between Carey's NCAA and elite seasons.

Kayla DiCello: High-scoring potential is one thing, but consistency is another. After a fall on uneven bars and a rough performance on balance beam, DiCello needs to show at trials that she can deliver under pressure.

Watch list

Shilese Jones: If she's healthy, she's on the team. These next three weeks will be big.

Kaliya Lincoln: Lincoln withdrew from nationals midway through the first night with an injury but petitioned into Olympic trials. Could add a big score on floor exercise.

US men's gymnastics team is taking shape

FORT WORTH, Texas — Given the selection procedures for the U.S. men's gymnastics team practically require a Ph.D. in math to understand, and are heavily dependent upon results at the Olympic trials later this month, predicting who is going to the Paris Games is something of a fool's errand.

But we're going to do it anyway! The short version of the selection procedures is the trials winner locks a spot on the Paris squad, so long as he's also in the top three on three or more events. U.S. champion Brody Malone was close to that at nationals, finishing first on high bar, second on still rings, fourth on pommel horse and fifth on parallel bars last weekend.

Even if he doesn't have those three top-threes, however, Malone is all but assured of going to Paris. He's less than a year removed from his third surgery to repair a gruesome knee injury and only decided a few weeks ago to do the all-around here, yet he won his third title easily.

Malone has had success internationally, too, finishing fourth in the all-around at the world championships in 2022, the same year he won the title on high bar.

As for the other four spots ... The selection procedures require the team to be picked based on who would give the Americans the best scores in both qualifying, when teams can drop their lowest score on each event, and finals, where three gymnasts compete on each event and every score is counted.

There's no scenario in which Malone wouldn't be at the top of both of those lists. In fact, in team finals, he'd prob-

ably contribute on every event but floor exercise, and maybe vault.

Fred Richard and Khoi Young, who were second and third to Malone at nationals, can probably start packing, too.

Richard, the bronze medalist in the all-around at last year's world championships, would be the U.S. anchor on floor and could also contribute on high bar and still rings.

Young is actually good on pommel horse — long the bane of existence for the U.S. men — and was the silver medalist on it at last year's world championships. He could anchor vault, as well,

having won a silver in that event, too, and could give the Americans a third big score on parallel bars.

Yul Moldauer puts up big numbers on parallel bars and floor exercise, and could contribute on vault and rings, too.

If you've been crunching the numbers, you see there's still a hole to fill on floor, pommel horse, vault and high bar. And if you've been looking at the scores from nationals, you see that, as things stand now, Paul Juda is the guy for that last spot.

Juda was sixth in the all-around at nationals, a full point behind Shane

Wiskus. But look at Juda's best events, and you see he could provide what the U.S. men still lack.

- His 14.75 on floor the first night was the second-best score on the event of the entire meet.

- Only Young, Malone and the specialists were better on pommel horse.

- His vault score on Day 2 trailed only Young.

- Juda, Malone and Richard were the only guys to go 14 or better on high bar, Juda doing it on the second night.

There are other options, of course. The U.S. men could take specialists Stephen Nedorosic or Patrick Hoopes to get another big score on pommel horse, their weakest event in the three-up, three-count team final format. But neither Nedorosic nor Hoopes do other events, meaning the Americans would be shoring up one event at the expense of three others.

And if any of the other four gymnasts got hurt, the U.S. men's hopes of winning their first medal since 2008 would take a serious hit.

They could take Wiskus, a Tokyo Olympian whose consistency is one of his greatest strengths. But Wiskus's best events are places where the U.S. men have other options that, at nationals at least, provide a higher score in the team final.

The reasoning is similar for bypassing Cameron Bock and Donnell Whitteburg. Unless someone is going to give you a decisive advantage on at least one event, the Americans are better off taking the guy who can give them coverage on the most events.

Of course, all this could change at Olympic trials. With the Paris Games now less than two months away, however, the team is starting to take shape.

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Swimming more than fun for Ledecky

Katie Ledecky, the greatest female swimmer in history, is known for winning Olympic gold medals in the most impressive fashion. But something few might be aware of is what happens when she comes into the post-race press conference, where she spends quite a bit of time deflecting attention from herself and focusing on her competitors.

So how does a person who would rather talk about others than herself actually write a book — about herself?

"You may have picked up on it that I did deflect a little bit by talking about all the people that have played such an instrumental role in my life," Ledecky said during a recent interview as she discussed her new memoir, the fabulously titled "Just Add Water," which was published Tuesday by Simon & Schuster.

"I guess that actually is talking about myself," she acknowledged, "but I really do feel like I'm the product of all the people around me, the people who have come before me, definitely my grandparents, my parents, my brother, my aunts and uncles, cousins. Really I don't think I would be the swimmer I am with-

out them. So it was great to be able to reflect on that and share a lot of their stories."

This is a big week for the 27-year-old Ledecky. In addition to the debut of her first book, she will compete at the U.S. Olympic swimming trials in Lucas Oil Stadium in Indianapolis (yes, a pool has been built inside an indoor football stadium) where she is expected to qualify for her fourth U.S. Olympic team in multiple events.

Ledecky will be one of the most-watched athletes at the Paris Games, where she will try to add to her Olympic cache of seven gold medals and three

silver. While she likely will be favored to win gold in the women's 800 and 1,500 freestyle events as she did in Tokyo three years ago, she will not go unchallenged as younger swimmers who grew up idolizing her are now some of her top rivals.

But first, she's dishing out some valuable advice in her new book, which in many ways is the perfect primer for parents and their athletic children.

As she details her childhood at a neighborhood pool in the suburbs of Washington, D.C., she had no aspirations of going to the Olympics. She was swimming just for fun.

"I've seen it with teammates that they tell the story of how right when they started swimming, they wrote to a first-grade paper that they wanted to go to the Olympics, or somebody declared that they were going to be an Olympian when they won the 25 free at age 8," she said.

"That was never me and that was never my family. I loved swimming and I definitely fell in love with it right from the start but I played other sports. I was pretty decent at basketball and soccer and was competitive and loved being active, so I loved all these things I was doing."

As for swimming, she said, "I watched it on TV but when I watched swimming, I never thought I would be at that level. I thought that that was some

other realm, I thought that's so far off and it wasn't really until I started qualifying for these bigger and bigger meets that all of a sudden qualifying for Olympic trials was the next meet and at that point, it came into the picture and I learned how you qualify for the Olympics."

But, she said, "It wasn't the goal from a young age. And so I think that is an important message, it's a message that you don't have to be great right from the get-go, you don't even have to have that goal right from the get-go, there are different journeys that everyone takes."

For anyone looking for tabloid drama or even a hint of scandal, this isn't the book for you. It's just the opposite, a delightful escape from our rancorous world to a place where hard work pays off and dreams do come true.

"I feel very fortunate that I have had a very happy life and no major injury or huge setback or abuse or anything in my life that has derailed me from the path that I've wanted to take," Ledecky said. "When I started writing this, I knew it would be a very positive story."

"Having that gold medal, seeing the way that it makes little kids smile, older people smile, it can light up somebody's face, and so just that impact is something that's very meaningful to me and if the book can be a small part of adding to that, then that's great and means a lot to me."

DeChambeau: 'Boring golf' key at Pinehurst

The 2020 U.S. Open champion is a social media star, from his TikTok page to his YouTube videos. He also made waves this year when he put 3D-printed irons into his golf bag, something that has led to top-10 finishes in the first two majors of the year.

When it comes to boring, DeChambeau is the polar opposite. He has become a fan favorite again in recent months because of his social presence, a title he didn't have in the months after his move to LIV Golf. But this week, as he prepared for the U.S. Open at Pinehurst No. 2, he is preaching boring.

"If I get my irons in a place where I'm hitting it in the middle of the greens, and just playing boring golf, that's the goal for me this week is to try to play as boring a golf as possible," DeChambeau said Tuesday.

But that's the challenge that Pinehurst No. 2 in North Carolina presents. While it can reward big tee shots, it's a ball-striker's course that will penalize shots barely offline, and the putting surfaces are punishing to any shots that aren't in the correct location.

"Looking forward to a tough test of golf out here. Pinehurst is no joke," DeChambeau said. "You have to hit it in the middle of the greens. And this is a Boo Weekley quote, but the center of the

green never moves, so I'll try to focus on that this week."

DeChambeau has become so popular in part because he goes against the grain and is willing to try things no one else does, and he does it spectacularly. From single-length irons, swinging out of his shoes on drives and tinkering with every little aspect of his swing, he's not afraid to go out on a limb to gain an advantage while on the course.

However, at a major championship test that's a bit different than others, don't expect DeChambeau to swing for the fences on every tee box.

"It stinks hitting a 6-iron off the tee compared to a driver, but sometimes you've got to do it and you've got to make the right decision for shooting the lowest score out here," DeChambeau said. "There's numerous holes like 3, I'd love to go for that green every single day, and I may go for it. I don't know, you never know with me. Certainly on the tee box if it's downwind, I'll give it a go probably."

DeChambeau finished a shot behind Xander Schauffele at the PGA Championship, finishing at 20 under. It's more than likely the winning score will be significantly less than that this weekend, but that doesn't mean DeChambeau won't entertain the crowds as he has during the first two majors of the year.

"I'm looking forward to a great challenge this week," DeChambeau said. "It's a lot of boring golf. It's definitely different than Valhalla, but I'll try to do my best to show the crowd some fun drives and some hopefully long-made putts."

Rory McIlroy, wife reconcile

Nearly one month after Rory McIlroy filed for divorce from Erica Stoll, the four-time major champion confirmed that he's reconciled with his wife of seven years after the pair "resolved our differences."

An attorney representing McIlroy filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss the divorce documents on Tuesday, The Guardian reported. The announcement comes days before the start of the U.S. Open, an event McIlroy last won in 2011.

"There have been rumors about my personal life recently, which is unfortunate," McIlroy said in a statement to the outlet. "Responding to each rumor is a fool's game."

"Over the past weeks, Erica and I have realized that our best future was as a family together. Thankfully, we have resolved our differences and look

forward to a new beginning."

McIlroy and Stoll began dating in 2015 and tied the knot in April 2017 at Ashford Castle in Ireland. They welcomed daughter Poppy Kennedy McIlroy on Aug. 31, 2020, in Jupiter, Florida.

McIlroy, 35, filed divorce documents in Palm Beach County, Florida, on May 13, days ahead of the PGA Championship at Valhalla Golf Club in Louisville, Kentucky, where he finished tied for 12th place at 12-under.

Now, days before the first round of the U.S. Open get underway in North Carolina, McIlroy said he and Stoll have settled their differences and both "look forward to a new beginning."

The third-ranked golfer in the world has not won a major since 2014. He last won the U.S. Open in 2011 at Congressional Country Club in Bethesda, Maryland. McIlroy is one of the favorites to win the tournament, according to BetMGM odds.
