



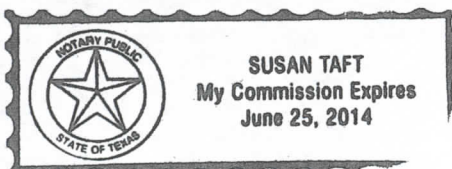

SXSW MOVIES

'Doc of the Dead' spans the life of zombie trend

And it will lumber on for a while, director says

AUSTIN The living dead have had movies and TV shows. Now they have their own documentary.

'Doc of the Dead,' directed by Alexandre Philippe (The People vs. George Lucas), covers the zombie genre from silent films through The Walking Dead. It premiered at the South by Southwest festival with showings Monday and Tuesday.

But zombie fans everywhere can see it Saturday at 8 p.m. ET/5 PT on Epix as part of a 24-hour

Zombie-thon that includes a new high-def remastered Night of the Living Dead and the TV premiere of World War Z.

"Zombies are a huge pop-culture phenomenon, probably the biggest right now," Philippe says.

For the feature-length documentary (81 minutes), he rounded up zombie sages including director George A. Romero (Night of the Living Dead), famed makeup artist Tom Savini (Dawn of the Dead), author Max Brooks (The Zombie Survival Guide, World War Z), and Walking Dead creator Robert Kirkman and producer Greg Nicotero.

roots of zombie legends and then bring the discussion to the modern zombie invasion, which began with Romero's 1968 black-and-white classic. "We were trying to create a new creature, somebody that was dead but came back," Romero says in the film.

What's zombies' appeal? "They are us, and they are us having succumbed to our own fear, which is our own death," says Simon Pegg, who co-wrote and starred in 2004's comedy take on zombies, Shaun of the Dead.

Then the discussion turns to how more modern takes on zombies have changed. "I loved the

zombies in World War Z" says Savini, who was in Austin with Philippe to promote the documentary. "That was really scary."

Philippe prefers Romero's slower, lumbering zombies. "But I'm not a zombie purist," he says.

The documentary surely won't be the last word on zombies, Philippe says. "I don't think we've seen the crest of the wave just yet. Zombies are going to just keep getting bigger."

Cult hero Moon Knight enters a new, 'bonkers' phase

Series is more crime than standard action

Moon Knight artist Declan Shalvey has hundreds of high-resolution pictures on his computer of fungi for a major comic-book challenge: how to visually imagine a mushroom death god.

It's just another day of working on one of Marvel Comics' strangest heroes with Warren Ellis, though even the best-selling British author wonders how exactly he's going to get odder than that.

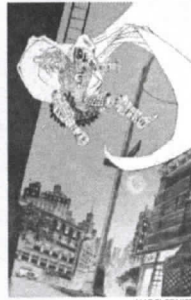
"What's the barometer for weird in the Marvel Universe?" asks Ellis, author of the novels *Gun Machine* and *Crooked Little Vein* and award-winning comic

writer of *Planetary*, *Hellblazer*, *Transmetropolitan*, and *Red* (which was turned into a Bruce Willis movie franchise).

Making its debut today, his and Shalvey's *Moon Knight* series may just define Marvel's capacity for "strange" while also redefining Marc Spector, a cult-favorite superhero who's pretty much as different from Captain America and Iron Man as one can get.

"He was a soulless mercenary who got killed on the one day he tried to act with decency, believed himself to have been brought back from the dead by an Egyptian god, and repaid that debt by dressing in a bedsheet and beating people up in the middle of the night," Ellis explains.

He sees it as a chance to do something very different than the standard commercial action comic, putting Moon Knight at the center of a procedural crime se-

ries that has horror, supernatural and hallucinatory elements but also explores the character's three distinct personalities.

The first issue has Spector investigating a nasty bit of S.H.I.E.L.D. business hiding in subterranean New York City. Subsequent stand-alone stories will feature an ex-military crew gone horribly wrong, an urban gang of ghosts and, in the fourth issue, a dreamscape where Moon Knight, the fist of Khonshu, faces a mushroom death god.

Marvel senior editor Nick

Lowe says it's potentially the most influential comic of its time, and one that also appeals to the mainstream.

For someone who's enjoying the equally immersive and twisty HBO series *True Detective*, "*Moon Knight* is a perfect book," he says. "It deals with these twisted criminals but with an almost medical look at it."

"It's fascinating and troubling in ways that make me think it's just a really wonderful, weird work of art."

Moon Knight is actually like Batman in many ways, Shalvey says. He's an ordinary guy who dresses up at night, fights crime with an array of gadgets and is relatively easy to draw compared with a mushroom death god.

"It's just so bonkers," he says. "In a way, it's been liberating. I have absolutely no idea what's going to happen next."

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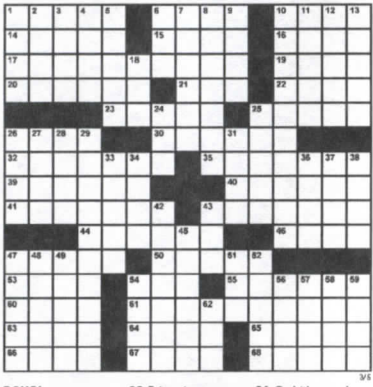
