has hope for continuing the legacy of the show (which surpasses the 20-year runs of Wolf's original "Law & Order" and "Gunsmoke" for the TV record).

"It's been an amazing climb back from the utter frustration of having 'L&O' canceled after 20, and that was one of the worst days of my entire 37year career," Wolf says. "SVU" co-star Ice-T "was actually the first one to say, 'Ah, we'll beat it' ... I started to believe, like, four years ago that it could actually happen, and now it has. And hopefully the next landmark could be 25.

Hargitay's compassionate detective has become a seminal TV heroine, bringing a listening ear and a drive for justice to a show that puts "special victims" at the forefront.

Hargitay gets visibly emotional as she talks about the impact of the show. "Especially when the material is so

good and layered and complex, you want to do it justice and elevate it if you can," she says. "Because of the subject matter, we all feel such a profound responsibility to do it right."

With the #MeToo movement shining light on high-profile instances of sexual harassment and assault, "SVU" feels especially relevant.

Hargitay, 55, has found a voice through her work on the series, taking courses on trauma, starting her Joyful Heart Foundation to support assault and abuse survivors and winning a News and Documentary Emmy for her "I Am Evidence" project about ending rape-kit backlogs.

"These stories are not new. This has been going on since the beginning of time. But it's getting the attention it deserves now, and it took a while," Hargitay says. "That's why I'm so grateful for the #MeToo movement and Time's Up because now our voices are in chorus together."

Wolf, 72, agrees, noting that "SVU"

topics of power and consent.

The show has portrayed "abusive producers, abusive directors over the years and lo and behold, when Harvey (Weinstein) broke it was like, 'Yeah, we did that episode seven years ago," Wolf says. "As opposed to 'Law and Order,' which I said for years 'we steal the headlines and not the body copy,' this show writes the headlines - early.

The new season again echoes Weinstein: Last week's opener looked at the head of a movie studio who's accused of fondling a young actress during an audition and forces her to watch him masturbate, And in a 2011 episode, "SVU" focused

on a billionaire accused of forcing an underage girl to give him an inappropriate massage, pre-dating the national attention surrounding Jeffrey Epstein. Part of the reason for the show's con-

tinued success? Teenage girls, Wolf

"With a deep dive of the numbers, that's why it's still on. We keep rolling has never shied away from the difficult over audiences, and as opposed to most

dramas, there's a younger segment that's just discovering" the show on digital platforms, he says.

There was a point, however, when "SVU" seemed endangered. What started as a two-detective show with Hargitay's Benson and Christopher Meloni's Elliott Stabler transformed when Meloni exited in 2011 after failed contract negotiations.

"This was a classic two-hander with her and Chris (Meloni). To go from a dual-lead show to a single-lead show, and to have it survive and prosper, is a miracle," Wolf says. "Everybody at NBC assumed the year after Chris left would be the last of the show, and she turned it around. It was a little-noted but huge accomplishment. It's amazing that the entire structure of the show changed."

The show has provided strong, complicated characters who "bear witness," Hargitay says, giving viewers a space to feel seen and talk openly about the gray areas and challenging discussions around assault and harassment for more than two decades.

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
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Gymnastics won't see another Simone



STUTTGART, Germany - When Simone Biles turned up at the national championships with a sequined goat on her training leotard, she meant it as a joke, a clapback at the trolls and critics.

But while Biles might cringe at the idea of actually calling herself the GOAT - greatest of all time - others will happily do it for her. Fellow gymnasts, coaches, icons of the sport – there is universal agreement that Biles is the best there is, of her generation and every other.

"If we're talking about domination, nothing like that has ever happened in our sport," Nadia Comaneci, who is still on a first-name basis with the world 40plus years after scoring gymnastics' first perfect 10, told USA TODAY Sports. "I don't think there will ever be anything like that. She's one of a kind."

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Biles is all but assured of winning the all-around title at the world gymnastics championships Thursday. She hasn't lost an all-around competition since nationals in 2013, and it's been five years since anyone's even gotten close to her. (It was Larisa Iordache of Romania, at the 2014 worlds, for those wondering.)

It would be her fifth all-around title. It also would be Biles' 22nd medal at the world championships, one less than the record set by Belarus' Vitaly Scherbo who did two more events, mind you.

But it's not just the medals and titles that set Biles apart. It's everything.

"It's what she's doing to the sport. She's revolutionizing it in a way I think no one will ever be able to do or has done," said Nastia Liukin, the 2008 Olympic all-around champion who is

now a commentator for NBC. "I don't think that anybody will ever top that."

Biles has near-perfect technique, which has allowed her to push the bounds of the sport physically. Look at the few men who have attempted the triple-twisting, double somersault that she does on floor, and none managed to do it as cleanly. They landed with their chests forward or their knees bent so they could control their landings.

When Biles did it during the team finals, she landed perfectly upright, her feet cemented to the floor. Oh, she got so much height that the people in the first half-dozen rows had to look up to watch

She now has four skills named for her, two on floor exercise and one each on vault and balance beam. Pretty much every one of her routines could be put on an instructional DVD – if there were a chance anyone could come close to duplicating what she's doing, that is.

"She's really absolutely out of this

world to me," said Svetlana Boginskaya, the 1989 world champion who now coaches in Biles' hometown of Houston. "It's alien gymnastics. It's inhuman gymnastics.

Most impressive is that Biles, with her power and precision, had changed the game before the Rio Olympics. But after taking a year off, she's come back even better. Stronger. With more diffi-

The triple-double on floor and a double-twisting, double somersault dismount off beam are new this year. The Biles vault was new last season. She's even improved uneven bars, her least favorite and "weakest" event, so much so that she was the silver medalist at worlds last year.

She's so superior that the International Gymnastics Committee watered down the value of her double-double on beam because they didn't want to encourage mere mortals to try it.

Liukin marvels at all of that, having

tried to come back for the 2012 Olympics. "People don't realize how difficult it actually is," Liukin said. "(They don't realize) how many different directions she's being pulled in on a constant, dayto-day basis."

Yet Biles has made it all look easy.

In some ways, that keeps her from getting the full credit she deserves. People are so used to Biles doing "Simone things" that we lose perspective on just how rare they – and she – are.

"That's been the hardest part for me," Liukin said. "To not tell myself, 'Oh, she's just Simone.' "

Biles is not doing this in a vacuum, either. The expectations on her are sky high, and she is nearing that crossover celebrity status. The video of her tripledouble at nationals practically broke the Internet, and she will no doubt be the face of the Tokyo Games with Michael Phelps and Usain Bolt now retired.

"She's the best thing about the sport right now because she is the sport at this particular point," Comaneci said.

At some point, Biles will retire - the 22-year-old says Tokyo will be her last Olympics - and new gymnasts will come along. That's how it is in sport. We're sure we've seen the greatest ever, only to have someone else do them one better. Bill Russell gave way to Michael Jordan who gave way to Kobe Bryant who gave way to LeBron James. Mark Spitz's records were eclipsed by Phelps. And so it goes.

But there are a few athletes who are transcendent - Phelps, Serena, Tiger, Brady - and Biles is among them. She is already doing skills that can't be matched. Before she is done, she will set records that won't be touched.

If anyone has earned the right to call herself the GOAT, it's Biles. Since she won't, we will.

Russia wins 1st world title, US men are fourth

STUTTGART, Germany - The U.S. men have their work cut out for them before the Tokyo Olympics.

After a near-perfect day in Wednesday's team finals, they were still fourth, well behind new world champion Russia, China and Japan. Worse, the gap was even bigger than it was last year, when the Americans were also fourth.

The U.S. finished more than seven points behind Russia, which won the world title for the first time since the breakup of the Soviet Union. The Americans were about 3½ points from the po-

But the Americans aren't ready to concede the Olympic podium, or any spot on it. Not when the Olympics are nine months away.

"It's going to be tough," Sam Mikulak acknowledged. "But our expectation going in is that we're going to put the pressure on. Hitting routines is how we're going to be as close as we can. We're just going to wait for the mistakes to happen on the other hand. That's going to be our saving grace.

"I can't promise we're going to get on that podium. But I can promise we're going to be a little better next year."

The U.S. men haven't won an Olym-

pic medal since their bronze in 2008. Their last world medal, also bronze, was in 2014. They were seventh in qualifying after a dismal performance, and only Mikulak (all-around, high bar) and Yul Moldauer (all-around) made event fi-

It's not for a lack of talent. Mikulak's score of 86.931 in the finals would win him a medal pretty much anywhere, and he tied for the second-highest score on parallel bars and was third best on both floor exercise and high bar. Moldauer was sixth on floor.

But the Americans lack consistency and, more important, difficulty.

In team finals, Russia had 11 routines with a start value of 6.0 or higher, while China had 10 and Japan 13. The Americans? Just six.

The start value reflects the difficulty of a routine and is combined with the execution score for the final total. Because they don't have anywhere close to Russia's, China's or Japan's difficulty, the Americans are in a deep hole even before the meet begins.

"Obviously we're doing what we can do," said U.S. coach Mark Williams, who is Moldauer's coach at Oklahoma. "The problem is, when you add difficulty, the execution goes down and so does the consistency."

The Americans are trying, though.

Brett McClure, the national team coordinator, said members increased their start values by "two- or three-tenths" on each event in the past year. If they can do that again ahead of Tokyo and clean up their bobbles and wobbles like Mikulak's and Moldauer's dismounts on pommel horse and Trevor Howard's landing on still rings – the U.S. will be getting somewhere.

"That combination of both will help us get to that 258 to 260 range," McClure said, referring to the point total needed to reach the podium at this worlds. "We'll have to be really good, close to perfect if not (perfect). But it's not out of

More depth also would help, Williams said.

Part of what makes the U.S. women so strong is there is a never-ending pipeline of talent. With only about a dozen spots available on the national team and even fewer for world and Olympic teams, the competition is fierce, and gymnasts are constantly pushing each other.

More than half of the men's national team retired after the Rio Olympics, leaving a dearth of talent and competi-

"There was a big hole that we have to fill," McClure said. "It's daunting thinking about it in one year, but each year we've started to bring more guys into the mix. ... You've just got to keep pushing forward and doing the same thing."

In the meantime, Mikulak and Moldauer will try and make the most of the chances they have left here.

"I just want to keep everything the same as today," Mikulak said. "Get in the same mind-set, just go out, repeat, have fun and keep that energy high."

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
