





Rules would aid used car buyers

Safety recalls' effectiveness would also get a boost

Government safety officials plan to an-nounce a final rule today more security for used car shoopers and dramatically boost the effectiveness of safety recalls. The National Higdway Traffic Safety Administration mandate will require automakers to have a todo on their public websites that allows any-one to search for uncompleted recall repairs for any car or truck by its ve-hicle identification number (VIN).
