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Pritchett / Big Sandy News

Everyone, I've spoken with is loving the cooler weather but missing the rain we so desperately need. Fall officially arrives on Sept. 22 but every Texas resident knows that our state never goes by the calendar when it comes to weather.

Our communities are excited about the Big Boy Locomotive's plan to stop in Big Sandy on Sept. 17. I am so impressed with the preparation and work of the city of Big Sandy prior to the big day.

The event is not only promoted by the city of Big City and surrounding cities in their news coverage, but also by the railroad. There is truly excitement in the air. See the separate article in today's Mirror.

In a recent community article I paid homage to the history of Glade Creek Church. When writing about this church I did so to honor their long-time commitment in our community that continues to this day.

This week I would like to recognize and honor another church in our community that is celebrating its 169th anniversary. New Hope Baptist Church was founded on Sept. 22, 1855 when a group of Christian people in the New Hope Community (located on Red Cedar Road) gathered together.

For the first 15 years they met in a one-room log house used as a school before constructing a log cabin.

The road conditions were bad during rain and winter months forcing the church to often just meet monthly.

In 1882, church members raised a new church in their same location using the best of lumber, being said of the lumber "there was not a knot hole in it."

In 1887, the list of church members totaled 146. In 1914, the church

again relocated to a new building, this time moving locations to the Crossroads Community on Aspen Trail south of Red Cedar. The cost of the move was just \$25, since much of the lumber from the previous location was used to build the new building.

It was still primitive by today's standards with windows open in the summer time for cooling, a wood stove for heat in winter months and outdoors.

My husband, Charles Glenn (Horsefly) included in his memories that the woman's outhouse was closer to the church and always kept painted and the males had a farther walk and no paint on their structure. He often said it was to honor the mothers and women of the church.

Aspen Trail was often called the Big Sandy Road because it was the only direct route joining Big Sandy to Gilmer and a well kept road though again primitive by today's standards.

After WWII, Texas 155 was completed and again the church relocated to the better traveled road. New Hope Baptist Big Sandy still sits 9.5 miles south of Gilmer on Texas 155 at the intersection of Mulberry.

This move, and to this day, in its construction a beam from the previous church locations was placed as it was built.

In 1970, a state historical marker was placed honoring 115 years. In 1978, to keep its historical designation, the structure had to be turned 90 degrees to allow the addition of the present day sanctuary.

When I reached out for comment from Pastor Ernest Graham about the upcoming 169th church anniversary his thoughts included this statement.

"How do we measure 169 years? A person's

life span is less than half of that many years," he stated.

"Yes, 169 years is a long time. Additionally, it is estimated around 14,700 churches closed their doors in 2023," he continued.

"If close to accurate, it is the most closings in one year ever recorded. So, considering the blessing of longevity, we are inviting everyone to join us for a moment of celebration of this wonderful work of our Lord of such a lengthy history — a true testimony of our Lord's grace, faithfulness, and goodness," he concluded.

The 2024 169th year homecoming anniversary of New Hope extends an open invitation to members, former members, and anyone wishing to visit on Sept. 22.

The celebration begins at 9 a.m. with donuts and fellowship. From 9:40-10:25 a.m. music will be provided by The Step Right Up Gospel Band.

At 10:30 a.m. the worship service begins followed by potluck and fellowship. Mark your calendars and make plans.

Hill's Farm, that is located here in Pritchett, has closed its doors for the season. Owners Michael and Stephanie Hill want to thank everyone for supporting your local farmers. They will open their doors in the spring when strawberries are in season.

I started this week's column with the weather and I'll finish with a small bit of Texas wisdom on the subject.

I recently read this: "You know you're from Texas when a cold front drops temperatures into the 80s ... and you are excited about it."

This girl is loving the low morning temperatures to drink coffee on the porch. Have a great week spread kindness around and I'll meet you back here next time.

Big Boy 4014 Locomotive to make 'whistle stop' at City of Big Sandy

The city of Big Sandy invites the public to join them and guests from all over the area to view the Big Boy 4014 Locomotive as it makes a "whistle stop" in their city on Sept. 17.

Virtual Railfan/Big Sandy on YouTube broadcasts the 24 hour a day movement of trains in the city everyday. The camera will capture the event as it happens.

Twenty-five of these giant locomotives were built exclusively for the Union Pacific Railroad and were delivered in 1941. Only seven engines exist today.

The Big Boy No. 4014 is 132 feet long and weighed 1.2 million pounds. It was retired in 1961 after traveling more than a million miles. The locomotive was restored and began touring the country in 2019 to

commemorate the 150th anniversary of the transcontinental railroad's completion. This trip it will go from its home base in Cheyenne Wyo. to Chicago before it turns south to Houston (including the stop in Big Sandy) and back to Cheyenne. This tour is called The "Heartland of America Tour."

Mayor Linda Baggett said, "The city is extremely honored to be recognized for their contribution to railroad history alive."

The Heritage Center on Gilmer Street is widely known as a place to view the movement of trains. The mayor demonstrated a large television there broadcasting YouTube's virtual Railfan/Big Sandy.

Preparations for the day include parking areas that are within walking

distance and parking at the Big Sandy Civic center and several churches offer shuttle services to deliver visitors to downtown. Many food trucks as well as local dining will be available.

Security, first aid, cooling stations and portapotties are all ready for the big day. The Big Sandy Museum will be manned by volunteer staff with some local rail history on display.

Friends from the National Railway Historical Society-North Texas Chapter will arrive the night before and be in attendance.

Elected/appointed officials from Big Sandy, Upshur County, the state and national levels are all invited. Several local business owners will be in attendance, along with representatives from surrounding cities and news organizations.

Hunting and fishing licenses on sale

Hunting and fishing regulations for the 2024-25 season are available online at outdoorannual.com, or the Outdoor Annual mobile

app. The mobile app is free, and once downloaded, it works without internet connectivity, making it easy for hunters and anglers to view regulations in even the most remote locations.

Other features include license lookup, location-based functionality such as "Hunting Seasons and Regulations by Location," "Where to Fish," and more.

A limited supply of printed booklets will be available at select TPWD offices. Hunters and anglers are encouraged to call their local offices to check availability.

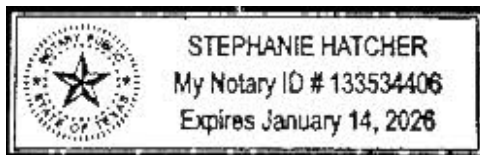

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Sporting Kansas City transfers Pierre. Why that's a win for player and club

A little over two weeks ago, Kayden Pierre bounded over to the side of the field after an intra-squad scrimmage, smiling ear to ear as usual.

Less than two days later, one of global soccer's most influential transfer insiders posted on X — to his 22 million social-media followers — about a deal sending Pierre from Sporting KC to one of the biggest clubs in Belgium: KRC Genk.

Sporting KC officially announced the transfer Wednesday morning, saying Pierre has signed a four-year contract. He'll begin with Jong Genk —

KRC Genk's second team — and work his way to the first-team squad.

While Sporting did not disclose financial details, multiple sources told The Star the club received more than \$1 million. And that figure that could increase if Pierre meets specific contract incentives. Sporting KC also retains a "sell-on percentage" for any future transfer of Pierre from Genk.

After Sporting KC's 3-0 win over Orlando City last weekend, Pierre made his rounds through the locker room to say goodbye. Some of the Sporting KC players had been academy teammates with Pierre during his seven years in KC.

It's certainly a bitter-sweet time for the 21-

year-old who has spent the most formative years of his life in Sporting KC's system.

"Some of the best memories of my life are gonna be here, and will be here," Pierre said. "Making my debut, first professional team, all these guys, all my friends that I made here ... I'll never forget this city for that."

Pierre came to Sporting KC at age 14 from Rochester, Michigan. He broke out toward the end of the 2022 season but tore a hamstring in his first appearance in 2023. Recurring hamstring injuries kept him off the field for a large part of his senior career in Kansas City.

And that's one thing Pierre wishes had gone differently here.

"I wish I really could have got on the field more to help this team out," he said, "because I think I could help this team out."

But this is how things go in pro soccer. Major League Soccer still isn't a destination league yet. Europe has the draw and the eye of so many young players, including Pierre. An opportunity to go to not only one of the better leagues in Europe, but also one of the best clubs in that league, was a major draw.

Genk has an extensive

history of developing and transferring talent onto the game's biggest stages.

"That project just stood out for me because I know it's a good league," Pierre said. "If I do good there, I could go anywhere pretty much."

Pierre had a contract option for the 2025 season with Sporting KC and could have gone anywhere for free. That sort of deal works well for both the player and the club.

Sporting nets a little more than \$1 million and can convert most of that

to allocation money. As such, it can be spread across the roster for the next couple of seasons — welcome flexibility for a team that has discussed undertaking a significant roster overhaul during the next winter transfer window.

Sporting KC does so by offloading a player who, while undoubtedly talented and promising, had difficulty staying healthy enough to see the field. Pierre has made just 34 first-team appearances and played a little under 2,000 minutes since making his first-team debut in the 2021 Leagues Cup.

Now he'll get a restart in a new setting, on an arguably higher platform for advancing his career.

After clinching a spot in the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup final last week, Sporting KC had the weekend off from MLS competition. Sporting KC returns to league action Saturday, taking on the New York Red Bulls at 6:30 p.m. Central Time in Harrison, New Jersey.

The U.S. Open Cup final will take place Sept. 25, Sporting KC facing LAFC for the championship.

"When the absolute winner is declared, they're there on the basis of being really good plus chance events," he said. "So that means the next year they could be just as good and not have those chance events work out on a couple things and then they fall back."

"So it's not really that they weren't as good; they just didn't have the things going for them that they need to win."

In that case, a Chiefs team that had won 12 straight games with its regulars (not counting a loss in the regular-season finale, in which Mahomes and most other key players were rested) was relegated to playing the Super Bowl with a decimated offensive line. The Tampa Bay Buccaneers won 31-9 that day.

Sure, that was an extreme example of "chance events" gone awry. And the Chiefs have navigated plenty of trap doors over these last few seasons — they became the first team to rally from double-digit deficits in all three post-season games en route to winning Super Bowl LIV and last season faced what was quite arguably the harshest postseason path in NFL history.

You could also say they've made plenty of their own luck, like when cornerback L'Jarius Sneed poked the ball loose from Baltimore's Zay Flowers at the goal line in the AFC title game.

And, happily for the Chiefs and their fans, another observation of Keefe's also remains as applicable today as it did nearly five years ago.

And it's a factor that can't be minimized, and hardly can be matched.

When it comes to the infinite impact of Mahomes, Keefe said, "You know his psychology has to be, 'I can do this. Where is it? Where's the lock that fits this key? Because I have a key.'"

That force of will and array of talent goes a long way toward leavening volatility around him. So does the guidance of the fourth-winningest coach in NFL history, who, in fact, leaves little to chance and often seems to control about all that can be controlled.

Moreover, whose starting offensive and defensive lineups would you rather have right now?

Still, that randomness, of health and quirky bounces and inexplicable mistakes, will have a say one way or another as the Chiefs take on the NFL's grueling recipe for equalizing.

And the dial could spin to one particular point of

identity that hovers as the most unsettling unknown of this team: experienced and reliable depth, particularly on defense and in both interior lines.

A year ago, one of the Chiefs' most vital developments was the way astute offseason free-agent signings Drue

Tranquill, Mike Edwards and Charles Omenihu came through down the stretch ... as the Chiefs were stretched thin.

Whether they'll enjoy that sort of benefit this time around, or be lucky enough not to have to face it much, can't be known until the season unfurls.

If it all sounds overwhelming, well, that's the nature of the unprecedented — and trying to create an identity for the ages.

team to win back-to-back Super Bowls since its inception in the 1966 season ...

And perhaps less of a wonder that zero of their repeat predecessors even made it back to the Super Bowl the third time around.

Never mind that with four Super Bowl appearances and three championships in the last five seasons, the Chiefs have transformed a title blight of 50 years into what now seems a birthright.

Forget that with the Mahomes-led offense reduced to a shadow of itself, last season seemed like a prime time for the league to administer a comeuppance instead of the Chiefs pulling off the encore.

(Or, as Veach put it during the Super Bowl parade: "Finally we see what a Chiefs down year looks like" — insinuating the rest of the NFL had its chance and should have gotten them while they could.)

And put aside, even, that the Chiefs apparently shored up that vulnerability in the offseason. Even with free-agent signee Hollywood Brown to miss the opener with a clavicle injury, rookie Xavier Worthy and second-year man Rashee Rice — who didn't find his stride until later in his first season — figure to give Mahomes much more to work with in the opener than he had last year. Not to mention that an injured Kelce missed that opening loss to the Lions.

That all seems like promising stuff. And it's part of why I fully expect to see the Chiefs back in the Super Bowl again.

Just the same, the trick still remains that their "new identity" is up against would-be new identities around the NFL. The rest of the league becomes more resentful of

the Chiefs by the year — and increasingly motivated to take them down.

So who and what will these Chiefs be, exactly?

Will the offense indeed return to more of what we've been accustomed to in the Mahomes era?

Can the defense be comparable to what it was a year ago, when it was second in the NFL in points and yardage allowed ... and so good it enabled a seismic late-season shift in emphasis that paved the way to the title?

Are they going to again get better after things go awry?

Perhaps most of all, though, there is this dynamic to ponder:

For sure, this all feels like part of a continuum within a magical era — accented by Taylor Swift's Eras Tour and her romance with Kelce that has helped make the Chiefs an increasingly international brand.

But it's actually a season all its own.

One in which these Chiefs are both sufficient to thrive and free to stumble on their own merits and flaws and the capricious twists of any given season.

As they entered the 2020 postseason seeking to win a second straight Super Bowl, I wrote a column about the psychology of the repeat — a pursuit for which that team was well-equipped in ample ways.

One of the people I spoke with then was Rich Keefe, the former director of sports psychology at Duke University and author of a book on the psychology of peak athletic performance called "On The Sweet Spot: Stalking The Effortless Present."

He made a compelling point that proved prophetic in Super Bowl LV a few weeks later and has stuck with me:

No more Nelly: KU basketball announces Lil Jon as new Late Night in the Phog performer

KU basketball fans can now turn down for Lil Jon in a little over a month. Grammy Award-winning producer, DJ and rapper Lil Jon will now headline KU's 40th Late Night in the Phog, the school announced on Wednesday. Late Night in the Phog is set for Friday, Oct. 18. Nelly was initially chosen to headline the event, but Kansas Athletics cited

"extenuating circumstances" in announcing the change in musical artist. Back in August, Nelly was arrested in a St. Louis area casino for suspected drug possession, according to an Associated Press story. His attorney, according to the AP's story, "said an 'overzealous' officer targeted him and conducted an improper search." Last year, Flo Rida was chosen to play at the KU event. "The five-time Grammy

nominee has amassed eight number one singles on Billboard's Rhythmic chart and several Billboard Hot 100 hit singles, including "Turn Down for What," which earned platinum status by the Recording Industry Association of America and passed the milestone of one billion views on YouTube. His hit single "Yeah!" won the Grammy for Best Rap/Sung Performance in 2005," a KU Athletics news release noted.

Late Night started in 1985 and features music by the KU pep band, routines from the KU spirit squad, coach and player introductions and scrimmages for both KU basketball teams.

Per the release, student gates will open at 5:15 p.m., while gates for the general public will open at 5:30 p.m. Students can claim tickets online.

Students can sit in the general admission section and receive access to the court for the concert on a first-come, first serve basis.

According to the release, KU will also host Phog Fest on the front lawn of Allen Fieldhouse before Late Night, with activities starting at 2:30 p.m.

The activities include the Hawk Zone with inflatable games, music and more. Phog Fest will also have food trucks, giveaways from various sponsors and interactive displays.

Free parking will be available in Lot 90, to the east and south of Allen Fieldhouse across Naismith Drive, starting at 2 p.m.

KU basketball entertaining prospects at home football games, despite relocation to KC

The Gateway District construction project at David Booth Kansas Memorial Stadium not only affects KU's football team on a home game day, but the men's basketball squad as well.

KU's hoops program not always, but quite often, brings a high school basketball prospect or two to Lawrence on a home football weekend. Typically, the recruits, after observing a practice, head to the stadium to watch a KU football game in the student section as part of the full official campus visit experience.

KU this season has two home football games scheduled at Children's Mercy Park and four at GEHA Field at Arrowhead Stadium in response to the stadium renovation in Lawrence.

KU basketball coach Bill Self hasn't changed his recruiting strategy for this school year. The current Jayhawk players are still bringing recruits who happen to be in town on official visits to the football games in Kansas City, even though the experience is a bit different from a game on KU's campus.

"We took our visitors (Eric Reibe, London Jemison) last week to Children's Mercy (for the KU-Lindenwood game). I'm sure we'll do the same

this week," KU coach Bill Self said in an interview with The Star on Monday. He did not mention any prospects by name in accordance with NCAA rules.

"Since we are hosting a home event, yes, they (recruits) can go. The 30-mile (rule) doesn't affect us if they want to go to the football game," Self added.

The NCAA has a rule that forbids college coaches and/or players from taking a prospect more than 30 miles from campus for entertainment purposes. Both Children's Mercy Park and Arrowhead are more than 30 miles from KU. The NCAA will not enforce that rule in this particular instance, since the KC games are official home games for the Jayhawks.

"It makes for a much longer day. Arrowhead definitely adds at least a couple hours to your day. It's fine. It's no big deal," Self said of driving to KC and back for one season's worth of football games, the trade-off being a renovated football stadium to be available for use in August, 2025.

Prospect Sebastian Williams-Adams, a 6-foot-7, 235-pound senior small forward from Houston who is making an official recruiting visit to KU this weekend, is expected to attend Friday's football game against UNLV, set for a 6 p.m. start at Children's Mercy Park.

"Football does more for our university, more financially for our athletic department and enthusiasm on campus in the fall," Self said recently as a guest on Seth Davis' Bleacher Report podcast.

"As far as helping basketball recruit, I still think there are a few other things in our lineup bigger than that. The games add excitement and energy. For football it is the same thing. The kids they bring in go to our games and it all adds to a good time.

The good times (watching another sport's athletes play a game) do not weigh as much as some other factors involving recruiting. I don't know the top players in the country are going to say, 'I want to go to Kansas; their football team is having success.' Lance (Leipold, KU football coach) and his staff do a great job. It does help us with energy."

Self is a big supporter of KU football. He has a suite at Memorial Stadium and has attended most of KU's home games in his 22 seasons in Lawrence.

"It's fantastic," he said of the KU football program in a recent interview.

Leipold, who took over a program that struggled for many years, is 18-22 in four years at KU with appearances in two straight bowl games.

"Who would have thought in this short amount of time that we'd be in a position we're in from a football standpoint? Travis (Goff, AD) deserves a lot of credit for getting the right guy. Lance deserves a lot of credit for putting together the right staff and reaching to believe they are good enough, (saying), 'If we do things right, we are good enough to beat people,'" Self said.

"The players deserve the lion's share of the credit because as well as Lance coaches them and put them in the right place, those kids have got to execute, do what he wants them to do. It looks to me from afar they are putting themselves in the best position to win every Saturday."

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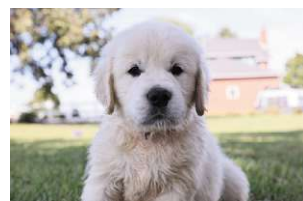

Notre Dame, USC lead teams making major moves in NCAA Re-Rank

Georgia locks down on No. 1, Notre Dame breaks into the top five and Southern Cal is one of several teams making a big move in the first updated USA TODAY Sports NCAA Re-Rank 1-134 of the 2024 season.

Already atop the 134 in the preseason, the Bulldogs are the no-doubt No. 1 after picking apart Clemson in Saturday's 34-3 win. The loss drops the Tigers 19 spots to No. 27.

Notre Dame climbs two spots to No. 5 after winning 23-13 at Texas A&M. The Fighting Irish replace Oregon, down two spots to No. 6 after struggling to beat Idaho. USC is up 14 to No. 9 after beating LSU 27-20 in Las Vegas, while the Tigers drop 10 to No. 16.

Another team climbing the re-rank is No. 14 Miami, up 12 after embarrassing Florida. Arizona State soars 49 spots to No. 56 after beating Wyoming 48-7.

No. 10 in the preseason 1-134, Florida State is now No. 59 after losses to Georgia Tech and Boston College. Virginia Tech drops 33 spots to No. 53 after losing in overtime at Vanderbilt, and Florida is down to No. 81 after starting this must-win season with a flop against the Hurricanes.


